

Remarks on Board Ship Wm. Hamilton

Wednesday March 16th Commenced with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same all hands employed in ships duty went to work
Lat 50° 25' N Long 179° 00'

Thursday March 17th Commenced with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same the watch employed in ships duty went to work
Lat 50° 26' 40"

Friday March 18th Commenced with moderate breeze from the SE middle and latter part the same the watch employed in ships duty went to work
Lat 50° 27' 00"

Saturday March 19th Commenced with strong breeze from the SE Ship under Double Reefed sails middle and latter part the same two transverse sail in sight at 11 AM spoke Ship American of Nantucket 22 months out with 880 bls Oil at 2 PM saw sperm Whales lowered the Boats and obtained one to the Larboard Boat took it along side went there 24 hours
Lat 50° 26' 10"

Sunday March 20th Commenced with strong breeze from the SE middle and latter part the same all hands employed in buting and boiling 10 ends
Lat 50° 26' 00"

Monday March 21st Commenced with strong breeze and squally with rain from the SE middle and latter part the at 11 AM finished boiling 10 ends
Lat 50° 25' 20"

Tuesday March 22nd Commenced with strong breeze and rain from the SE middle and latter part the same the watch employed in ships duty went to work
Lat 50° 25' 00"

Wednesday March 23rd Commenced with strong gale from the SE middle and latter part the same the ship lying too under a Joostring, main top sail 10 ends

On a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific Ocean

Thursday March 24th Commenced with strong breeze from the SE middle and latter part moderate made sail all hands employed in ships duty spoke the Ship Meridian 20 ends there 24 hours
Lat 50° 26' 00"

Friday March 25th Commenced with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same at 7 AM spoke Ship Lone of Nantucket 22 months out 500 bls Oil the watch employed in ships duty went to work
Lat 50° 26' 00" Long 176° 00"

Saturday March 26th Commenced with moderate breeze from the SE middle and latter part the same at 3 PM saw a Sperm Whale in Company with the Ship Meridian and mated with her the Meridian's Boats took the Whale 20 ends
Lat 50° 27' 00"

Sunday March 27th Commenced with moderate breeze at 10 AM saw a large Sperm Whale lowered the Boats and succeeded in taking him to the waist Boat took it along side and cut it in the Meridian saw Whales and took one, middle and latter part moderate 10 ends 24 hours
Lat 50° 27' 20"

Monday March 28th Commenced with moderate breeze from the SE middle and latter part the same at 7 AM saw Sperm Whales lowered the Boats and captured one to the Bow Boat took it along side and cut it in all hands employed in buting and boiling 10 ends
Lat 50° 27' 00"

Tuesday March 29th Commenced with moderate breeze middle and latter part the same all hands employed in boiling 10 ends the watch
Lat 50° 28' 10" Long 175° 00"
