Saturday April 16th Commences with light breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same all hands employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours in sight of Cook

Sunday April 17th Commences with light breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours in sight of Cook

Monday April 18th Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours in sight of Cook

Tuesday April 19th Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. at 4 o'clock parted Company with the Mermaid at 9 o'clock spoke Ship India of New Bedford 18 months out with 1400 bl Oil the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday April 20th Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Thursday April 21th Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same at 5 PM saw sperm Whales lowered the Boats did not fasten a strange sail in sight the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Friday April 22nd Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Saturday April 23rd Commences with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same the water employed in Ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Sunday April 24th Commences with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same at 4 PM saw a shoal of sperm Whales lowered the Boats and succeeded in taking two one to the waist Boat and one to the Row Boat and took them alongside so ends these 24 hours

Monday April 25th Commences with moderate breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same all hands employed in Cutting and boiling two strange sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday April 26th Commences with light breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same at 7 o'clock saw several large sperm Whales lowered the Boats and succeeded in taking two one to the waist and one to the Row Boats took them alongside and put one in two strange sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday April 27th Commences with light breeze from the Eastward middle and latter part the same all hands employed in Cutting and boiling so ends these 24 hours

Thursday April 28th Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. middle and latter part the same all hands employed in Boiling so ends these 24 hours
