Friday July 1st 1836 Commences with moderate breezes from the Westward middle and latter part the same all hands employed in ships duty so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 19:43 Long by Ch^m 145:13

Saturday July 2nd Commences with light breezes from the Westward middle and latter part the same at 6 P.M. saw two of the Society Islands Oahu and Oahu all hands employed in ships duty so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 18:21

Sunday July 3rd Commences with light breezes from the Westward at 4 P.M. came to an anchor at Oahu

Monday August 13th 1836 Commences with moderate breezes at 10 P.M. weighed and made sail for Huahine after laying in Oahu six weeks and Coopering 2800 lbs oil painting ship &c so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday August 14th Commences with moderate breezes at 1 P.M. came to an anchor at Huahine in Comm. with the Ship *Waverley* of New Bedford, so ends these 24 hours
