Tuesday August 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes at 9 AM weighed anchor and made sail in company with the Navigator, so ends these twenty four hours

Wednesday August 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the SE at 3 AM sent two boats on shore at the Island of for Coco nuts, midland latter part pleasant, still in company with the Navigator, so ends these 24 hours

Thursday August 18<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the SE at 9 AM sent the Boat on shore at the Island of Maura and obtained some Hogs, so ends these 24 hours

Friday August 19<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong breezes from the SE midland latter part the same the rest employed in repairing sails still in company with the Navigator so ends these twenty four hours

Saturday August 20<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong breezes from the SE midland latter part the same the watch employed in repairing sails so ends these 24 hours

Sunday August 21<sup>st</sup> Commences with strong breezes from the Eastward midland latter part equally with rain the watch employed in ship's duty so ends these 24 hours  
Lat by obs 14:30 Long by obs 157:43

Monday August 22<sup>nd</sup> Commences with strong breezes from the SE midland latter part the same all hands employed in fitting rigging so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday August 24<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the SE midland latter part the same all hands employed in the rigging so ends these 24 hours

Thursday August 25<sup>th</sup> Commences with light breezes from the SE midland latter part squally with rain all hands employed in fitting the rigging so ends these 24 hours  
Lat by obs 14:20 Long by Ch 164:23

Friday August 26<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the SE midland latter part the same all hands employed in fitting rigging, so ends these 24 hours  
Lat by obs 14:16 Long by Ch 165:45

Saturday August 27<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the Eastward midland latter part the same all hands employed in fitting rigging so ends these 24 hours  
Lat by obs 14:19 Long by Ch 167:54

Sunday August 28<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the Eastward at 8 AM saw some sperm Whales convened the Boats in company with the Navigator, and obtained one to the main Boat took it along side and cut it in, one of the Navigators Helms in sight so ends  
Lat by obs 14:10 Long 168:40

Monday August 29<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from the SE at 11 AM saw sperm Whales convened the Boats and succeeded in capturing three two large and one small one, one to the Starboard one to the main and one to the Bow Boats took them along side and cut the small one all hands employed in cutting and boiling so ends these 24 hours
