Tuesday, Dec. 20th Commences with moderate breezes from the SE at 6 AM weighed anchor made sail and stood out, middle and latter part pleasant, so ends

Wednesday, Dec. 21st Commences with moderate breezes from the Southward middle and latter part the same the watch employed in repairing sparker, so ends the 24 hour

Thursday, Dec. 22nd Commences with strong breezes from the SE middle and latter part the same the watch employed in repairing sails, so ends the 24 hour
Lat 24:29 Long by Chron 180:00

Friday, Dec. 23rd Commences with moderate breezes from the SE middle and latter part the same the watch employed in repairing sails, so ends the 24 hour
Lat 26:31 Long by Chron 178:00 East
