

Remarks on board Ship *Wm. Hamilton*

Wednesday June 7th Commences with moderate breezes from the NW Course NW middle and latter part moderate breeze from the West the watch employed in ship's duty is over
Lat 40° 22' 48" Long 148° 38' 30"

Thursday June 8th Commences with moderate breeze from the NW middle and latter part light breeze from the South the watch employed in ship's duty is over
Lat 40° 50' 46" Long 146° 14'

Friday June 9th Commences with moderate breeze from the South Course NW middle and latter part strong breeze from the NW took in standing sails and top galant sails
Lat 40° 48' 53" Long 144° 53' 52"

Saturday June 10th Commences with strong breezes from the NW Course NW at 3 double reefed the top sails middle part strong gale and squally at 4 called all hands forward and main top sail sheets and main brace reefed the main sail and close reefed the top sails at 5 took in the main and mizen top sails and main sails latter part squally. Pending in fore a shore reef fore top sail and fore sail is over these 24 hours
Lat 40° 46' 29" Long 141° 44'

Sunday June 11th Commences with strong gale from the South latter part moderate made all sail the watch employed in repairing fore sail, saw a ship steering SW and
Lat 40° 44' 25" Long 140° 10'

Monday June 12th Commences with strong gale from the NW at 1 took in top galant sails at 4 double reefed the top sails took in jib and main sail at 10 took in fore and mizen top sails and close reefed the main latter part strong gale took in the fore sail is over these 24 hours
Lat 40° 43' 35" Long 137° 57'

Tuesday June 13th Commences with strong gale from the NW middle part more moderate set double reef top sails jib and main sail latter part moderate made all sail, over
Lat 40° 42' 30"

Wednesday June 14th Commences with moderate breezes from the West Course NW latter part light breeze from the South with all sail set the watch employed in ship's duty is over
Lat 40° 40' 48" Long 140° 49' 10"

Thursday June 15th Commences with light breeze from the West latter part strong gale from the NW took in the top galant sails at 10 double reefed the top sails and took in jib and main sail, over
Lat 40° 40' 56" Long 139° 00'

Friday June 16th Commences with strong gale from the North latter part moderate made sail, the watch employed in ship's duty is over these 24 hours
Lat 38° 46' Long 148° 30'

Saturday June 17th Commences with strong breezes from the North middle and latter part the same the watch employed in ship's duty is over these 24 hours
Lat 37° 35'

Sunday June 18th Commences with strong breezes from the North at 8 took in top galant sails at 1 took in the top sails middle and latter part strong gale is over
Lat 37° 18' Long 148° 00'

Monday June 19th Commences with strong gale from the NW at 4 took in jib and main sail and double reefed the top sails at 9 took in the fore and mizen top sails latter part strong breeze from the West Course NW set double reef top sails jib and main sail at 10 set single reef top sails and top galant sails
Lat 37° 24' Long 145° 10'

Tuesday June 20th Commences with light breeze from the South all sail set middle and latter part the same the watch employed in ship's duty is over these 24 hours
Lat 35° 02' Long 148° 16'

Wednesday June 21th Commences with light breeze from the South latter part strong gale from the NW took in the top galant sails jib and main sail and double reefed the top sails, over these 24 hours
Lat 33° 28' Long 148° 10'
