Sunday, April the 7th
Commences with strong gales from S & S.E. heading
N.E. under A. Close reefed main top sail & fore sail
at 7. wore ship to the S.W.
Lat. 26. 00. Long. 158. 00.

Monday, April the 8th
Commences with hard gales from S & S.E.
heading S.W. latter part more moderate
set double reefed top sails.
Lat. 26. 02. Long. 158. 40

Tuesday, April the 9th
Commences with strong gales from S & S.E.
heading S.W. under double reefed top sails
at 6. wore ship to the N.E. under short sail
Lat. 25. 37. Long. 158. 54

Wednesday, April the 10th
Commences with strong gales heading N.E.
at 6. wore ship to the S. at 6. S.W.
set double reefed top sail fore & main sail
Middle & latter part strong breezes.

Thursday, April the 11th
Commences with strong breezes from the S heading
to the S.W. at 10. took in sail & wore ship to
the N. latter part all employed in stowing down
sail
Lat. 26. 16 Long. 158. 20

Friday, April the 12th
Commences with strong gales at 6. took in sail
stowing down Middle & latter part the same
Lat. 25. 08. Long. 158. 00

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Saturday, April the 13th
Commences with hard gales from the S heading to the
S.W. saw a brig standing to the N. Middle & latter part
same.
Lat. 26. 09. Long. 158. 00

Sunday, April the 14th
Commences with hard gales still strong, too under a close
reefed main top sail latter part set the fore sail, raring
Lat. 27. 00. Long. 158. 00

Monday, April the 15th
Commences with strong breezes from S & S.E. heading S.W.
latter part more moderate set double reefed top sails
& main sail.
Lat. 28. 20. Long. 159. 28. 8

Tuesday, April the 16th
Commences with light winds from S & S.E. heading to the
S.W. Middle & latter part the same with rain.

Wednesday, April the 17th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.E. Course
by S.W. Middle & latter part the same saw black fish
Lat. 31. 07. Long. 158. 00

Thursday, April the 18th
Commences with hard gales from the S & S.E. heading
S.W. at 10. took in sail & took in the
main top sail blowing strong gale. at 7. S.W. set the
main top sail & fore & main heading S.W.
Lat. 31. 06. Long. 158. 20. 8

Friday, April the 19th
Commences with hard gales from the S & S.E. at 2. saw 3
English bargues all steering N.W. latter part the same
heading S.W.
