Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. steering to the S.W. middle & latter part the same

Sunday June the 16th
Commenced with strong breezes & squally Course N by E at 7. A.M. saw Lillona reef.

Monday June the 17th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S. steering to the S.W. at 1 A.M. saw Solomon's islands at 6 hauled on the wind to the S.W. under short sail at 8 P.M. saw a large whale going quick to the windward did not lower.

Lat. 11. 20. Long. 157. 24 East

Tuesday June the 18th
Commenced with light breezes the land in sight course variable middle & latter part the same saw finbacks

Lat. 11. 15. S.

Wednesday June the 19th
Commenced with light breezes & calm at 1 P.M. sent 2 boats on shore at Lillona island at 5 returned saw one Indian & he ran so fast that we could not see his heels for dust. latter part calm several islands in sight

Lat. 10. 31. Long. 157. 15 East

Thursday June the 20th
Commenced with light winds & calm 2 large islands in sight saw finbacks & grampuses.
