Friday, Nov. the 15th
Commences with light breezes Middle part
squally with rain latter part light breezes from
the S. E. saw black fish spoke the brig
piece of sideways land in sight so ends

Saturday, Nov. the 16th
Commences with light breezes from the S. E.
Middle part squally latter part light breezes
in Company with the brig so ends with
land in sight

Sunday, Nov. the 17th
Commences with light breezes from the
S. E. the brig in Company heading to the
S. E. latter part wind from the S. W.
heading in for the land so ends

Monday, Nov. the 18th
Commences with light breezes from all
points of the Compass Course S. E.
2. Canoes along side a sail in sight to the
leeward so ends

Tuesday, Nov. the 19th
Commences with light breezes & calm.
Middle & latter part the same the same, the
watch employed in mending sails a sail in sight
& land to the windward

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Wednesday, Nov. the 20th
Commences with light breezes from the S. E. Course
S. E. running along the shore of Bougainville Middle
& latter part squally with rain & heavy thunder &
lightning, a sail in sight wind from the S. E.
heading of shore under double reefed top sails

Thursday, Nov. the 21st
Commences with strong breezes from the N. E.
at 1. tacked Ship Course S. E. for the Straits
of Bougainville, at 2. tacked of shore wind from
the S. E. with light rain, at 3. tacked Off
Wind from the S. E. Course S. E. so ends, running
along the shores of New Georgia

Friday, Nov. the 22nd
Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E.
Course S. E. at 2. several Canoes came off from
the S. E. shore, Middle & latter part calm the watch
employed in repairing the fore sail, took a man of
from one of the canoes

Lat. 1. 31. S

Saturday, Nov. the 23rd
Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E.
heading to the S. E. Middle & latter part the same
land in sight from the mast head so ends

Lat. 2. 33. S Long. 156. 21. E

Sunday, Nov. the 24th
Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. heading
S. E. Middle & latter the same, once more out of sight
of Solomon Islands

Lat. 11. 17. S Long. 156. 12. E
