

Remarks on board of the ship, William Hamilton.

Sunday, March the 1st
Commences with strong breezes from the S.E.
heading S.E. at 4, wore ship to the S.W.
& made sail Middle & latter part more moderate
so ends, with single reefed top sails & main top gall sail

Lat. 25° 33' S. Long. 153° 34' East

Monday, March the 2nd
Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E.
heading S. Middle & latter part the same, all
hands employed in stowing down oil, so ends

Lat. 26° 12' S.

Tuesday, March the 3rd
Commences with light breezes from the S.E. heading
S. at 6, finished stowing down & wore ship
to the N.E.

Lat. 25° 30' S.

Wednesday, March the 4th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E.
heading S. latter part the same, so ends.

Lat. 26° 37' S.

Thursday, March the 5th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E.
heading S. at 5, wore ship to the N.E. & took
in the fore & main top sails & close reefed the main
latter part hard gales with rain, so ends.

Friday, March the 6th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading
N.E. under a close reefed main top sail & fore spinnaker

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Saturday, March the 7th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading
S.E. at 4, P.M. took in the bow boat, at 5, took
in the main top sail & fore sail, latter part the same,

Lat. 24° 31' S.

Sunday, March the 8th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. at 1, set
a close reefed main top sail, heading S.E. latter part the
same so ends.

Monday, March the 9th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading
S.W. under a close reefed main top sail & fore sail
Middle & latter part the same, so ends.

Lat. 23° 34' S. Long. 160° 10' East

Tuesday, March the 10th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading
S.W. under a close reefed main top sail & fore sail
Middle & latter the same with rain so ends.

Wednesday, March the 11th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading
S.E. with rain Middle part more moderate at 7,
wore ship to the S.E. wind from the N.E. at 9 P.M.
kept off S by E & set the fore top sail latter part set
a close reefed top sail, so ends.

Lat. 23° 42' S.

Thursday, March the 12th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.E.
heading to the S.E. Middle part rainy, so ends.

Lat. 25° 26' S. Long. 161° 53' East
