Sunday, April the 22nd
Commences with light breezes from the S.E. heading
E.S.E. at 6. tacked to the N.E. latter part moderate
at 6 P.M. commenced stowing down oil. at 7. tacked
ship to the N. so ends.

Commences with light breezes from the S.E.
latter part from the N.E. steering to the S. at 12.
finished stowing down. so ends.

Lat. 25.15. S.

Tuesday, April the 24th
Commences with light breezes from the N.E. heading
to the S. Middle & latter part the same so ends.

Wednesday, April the 25th
Commences with light breezes from the N.E. latter part
from the W.S.W. heading S.E.W. latter
part light squalls of rain. so ends.

Thursday, April the 26th
Commences with light breezes from the S.W. heading
N.W. at 6. tacked ship to the S. latter part the same

Friday, May the 1st
Commences with light breezes from the W.
at 6. spoke an English bark latter part heading
to the W. so ends.

Commences with light from the S. at 8. P.M. tacked
ship to the W.S.W. latter part the same so ends.

Sunday, May the 3rd
Commences with light breezes from the S.E. at 12.
P.M. tacked ship to the E. latter heading S.N.E. so ends.

Lat. 25.09. Long. 163.52.

Monday, May the 4th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.E. heading
S.E. under single reefed top sails at 6. wore ship
to the S. latter part strong gales.

Lat. 24.09. Long. 165.

Tuesday, May the 5th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading
Middle & latter part the same so ends.

Lat. 25.09.

Wednesday, May the 6th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading
S. Middle & latter part the same so ends.

Lat. 26.22. Long. 163.54.

Thursday, May the 7th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading
S. at 6. P.M. wore ship to the S. so ends.
