

Remarks on board of the Ship. William Hamilton.

Sunday. Oct. the 18. th
Commences with strong gales with rain Course
N. E. W. latter part S. W. by S
Lat. 17.44. S. Long. 142. 41. E

Monday. Oct. the 19. th
Commences with a calm latter part light breezes
from the S. Course S. E. W. saw fin-backs so ends
Lat. 22.42. S. Long. 141. 40. E

Tuesday. Oct. the 20. th
Commences with light breezes from S. Course S. E. W.
latter part strong gales, at 6. saw sperm whales
lained the boats & obtained three. 4. to the starboard
ward - 2. S. B. boats at 11. took them to the ship so ends
Lat. 23.08. S. Long. 141. 40. E

Wednesday. Oct. the 21. th
Commences with strong breezes from the S. at 12
began to cut. at 1 finished. Course S. at daylight began
to hoist. latter part Course N. E. W. saw a sail
heading to the Eastward.
Lat. 30. 20. S. Long. 139. 30. E

Thursday. Nov. the 1. st 18
Commences with strong gales from the S. E. Course
S. W. by W. at 12. tacked heading S. E. by E. at daylight saw
Lord Howe Island. at 8. cooled down the works latter
latter part strong gales from the W. with rain. so ends

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Monday Nov. the 2. nd
Commences with strong gales from the S. E. heading S
at 1. O'clock. started the work at 2 finished hoisting at 8. 3. 16
sent the boats on shore afishing so ends.

Tuesday. Nov. the 3. rd
Commences with strong breezes from the S. E. at 4. the
boats returned with 1. 1/2 bl. of fish at 6. Charles
Brochar Cooper of the ship. Departed this life after
3 months sickness. Aged 52 years, he was born at St.
Domingo one of the West India Islands, he was buried
on Lord Howe Island. in the Latitude of 31. 26. 9. S Longitude
of 152. 00 East so ends.

Wednesday. Nov. the 4. th
Commences with moderate breezes from the S. E. Course N. E. W.
middle & latter part the same saw nothing, so ends.

Thursday. Nov. the 5. th
Commences with strong gales from the S. heading N. E. W.
middle & latter part light breezes so ends. Lat. 31. 15. S

Friday. Nov. the 6. th
Commences with light breezes & calm heading N. E. latter part
light breezes from the S. heading N. saw jumbies & fin-backs
Lat. 31. 40. S. Long. 138. 49. E

Sunday. Nov. the 8. th
Commences with light breezes from the S. heading S. E. latter
part S. E. by E. saw jumbies
Lat. 31. 42. S. Long. 138. 46. E

Thursday. Nov. the 12. th
Commences with strong gales from the S. E. heading S
under short sail latter part back gales from the S. E. heading
N. E. W. so ends. Lat. 36. 12. S
