Saturday Nov. the 14th
Commences with hard gales from the S.W. at 1. wore ship,
set the fore sail & double reefed top sails, Course S Middle
& latter part light winds & courses. Variable so Ends. saw
nothing.

Lat. 35. 18. Long. 16. 12. E

Sunday Nov. the 15th
Commences with light breezes from the N. Courses
Variable latter part foggy. so Ends. with killers in sight
Lat. 36. 01. S. Long. 16. 6. E

Monday Nov. the 16th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. heading
S.W. at 4. winds from the S.W. took in sail heading N.
latter part. More moderate made sail. Course N by N.
saw nothing. so Ends.

Lat. 37. 31. S. Long. 16. 05. E

Tuesday Nov. the 17th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.W.
Course N by N. Middle part W by N. latter part
light breeze saw porpoises. so Ends.

Lat. 37. 20. S. Long. 15. 41. E

Wednesday Nov. the 18th
Commences with light air from the S.W. heading N.
latter part strong breezes from the S. heading N.W.
so Ends.

Lat. 37. 20. Long. 15. 38. E

Thursday Nov. the 19th
Commences with strong breezes from the S.
heading N.W. under short sail saw the ship
lowered one boat & took on. latter part heading to the
S.W. saw a sail heading to the N. Lat. 37. 07. S. Long. 15. 10. E

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Friday Nov. the 20th
Commences with strong breezes from the S. Course S by N.
with light rain latter part. the same winds S.W.
Lat. 35. 20. S.

Saturday Nov. the 21st
Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. with rain
Middle part from the S.W. Course S by N. latter part the
same saw nothing.

Lat. 35. 10. S. Long. 16. 18. E

Sunday Nov. the 22nd
Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. Course
S by N. saw a bigg steering to the Westward latter part
steering S.W. saw a plenty of fin backs so Ends.
Lat. 35. 14. S. Long. 16. 09. E

Monday Nov. the 23rd
Commences with strong breezes from the S. steering
S.W. saw fin backs Middle part by by. latter steering S.W.
so Ends.

Lat. 36. 04. S

Tuesday Nov. the 24th
Commences with fresh gales from the S.W. heading S.W.
under a main top sail & fore sail saw fin backs latter part
strong gales heading S.W. so Ends.

Lat. 36. 42. S. Long. 16. 31. E

Wednesday Nov. the 25th
Commences with strong gales from the S. heading S.W. at 4.
wore ship to the N. latter part more moderate backed ship
heading S.W. under double reefed top sails fore sail. Gill & Shanker
saw nothing so Ends.
