Sunday, Jan'y the 3rd
Commenced with light breezes from the S. heading N.W.
a boiling, saw black fish Middle part Calm at 6. finished
boiling latter part light breezes from the S. steering S by W.

Monday, Jan'y the 4th
Commenced with light breezes from the S. steering S by W.
Middle part lay by, heading N.W. latter part
foggy the watch employed in coopersing oil so ends.

Lat. 44.5°

Tuesday, January the 5th
Commenced with strong breezes from the N. heading
N.W. at 1 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. foggy latter
part employed in stowing down oil light squalls of rain
so ends. saw black fish

Wednesday, Jan'y the 6th
Commenced with strong breezes from the N.W. heading N.W.
at 2 P.M. wore ship to the N.W. with rain latter part
wind from the E. with thick fog so ends.

Thursday, Jan'y the 7th
Commenced with light breezes from the S. with fog
& rain. Middle & latter part the same so ends.

Friday, Jan'y the 8th
Commenced with light breezes from the S. with
fog & rain heading to the N. latter part wind from the
W. heading S. so ends.

Lat. 45.10° Long 179.30

Saturday, January the 9th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S. heading S. foggy. latter
part pleasant steering to the S. so ends.

Sunday, January the 10th
Commenced with pleasant breezes from the S. steering to the
S. Middle part to the W. saw porpoises & sperm whales so ends.

Monday, January the 11th
Commenced with pleasant breezes from the S.W. steering N by S.
latter part wind from the S. all hands employed in stowing
down oil so ends.

Lat. 44.26° Long 179.26

Tuesday, January the 12th
Commenced with pleasant breezes from the S.W. steering N. at
2 P.M. finished stowing down saw porpoises latter part wind
from the S. saw black fish & fin backs so ends.

Lat. 44.40° Long 179.24

Wednesday, January the 13th
Commenced with pleasant breezes from the S.W. steering N.W.
saw black fish porpoises & fin backs Middle part lay by. latter part
laid up ship to the N. spoke the ship Good Fortune. Taker of
New Bedford 19 months out. 2800. whale 200. sperm oil so ends.

Lat. 44.70° Long 179.00

Thursday, January the 14th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S. with light
rain steering to the N. saw black fish latter part light breezes
from the N. steering to the N. at 6 P.M. saw Chatham Island

Lat. 44.19° Long 178.50

Friday, January the 15th
Commenced with light breezes from the S. heading N. the land
in sight the Good Fortune in Company saw black fish so ends.

Lat. 44.25° Long 178.20 W.
