Thursday Feb. the 18th
Commences with light breezes from the E & S heading
at 2. began to hoist at 4. wore ship to the
N. the Omega in sight at 2. finished boiling latter part steering
S. W. so ends
Latt. 22. 31. 9

Friday Feb. the 19th
Commences with strong breezes from the S & steering
W. Hunter's Island in sight latter part S. W.
Latt. 22. 59
Long. 172. 05

Saturday Feb. the 20th
Commences with strong breezes from the S & steering N
land in sight latter part to the S W. so ends
Latt. 23. 13. 9

Sunday Feb. the 21st
Commences with strong breezes from the E courses
variable middle part heading S & E under short
sail latter part steering W. Cloudy. No. obs.

Monday Feb. the 22nd
Commences with strong breezes from S & steering
W. the Omega in sight middle part heavy squalls
of wind & rain from S & heading N. at 4. took in
the main top sail. at 7. set the same wind S W.
Latt. 23. 13. 9

Tuesday Feb. the 23rd
Commences with strong breezes from the N W heading
N N E with light squalls of rain latter part strong
gales from the S & heading S W. so ends

Latt. 23. 16. 9 Long. 174. 26. E

Wednesday Feb. the 24th
Commences with strong gales from the S heading S W.
under short sail middle part moderate at 8. saw sperm whales
bowed the boats took 2. one to the starboard & to the bow had
the Omega in company so ends.

Thursday Feb. the 25th
Commences with strong breezes began to hoist at 7. P.M.
finished at 8. saw a large whale going quick to the
windward bowed the boats got nothing. at 12. began
to hoist so ends heading S E.
Latt. 22. 59. 9

Friday Feb. the 26th
Commences with strong breezes from the S & heading
S E latter part steering S W. saw a beach to the
windward so ends.
Latt. 23. 02. 9 Long. 171. 20.

Saturday Feb. the 27th
Commences with strong breezes from the S steering
S W at 4. finished boiling at 6. wore ship to the
S. latter part steering W N W. so ends.
Latt. 23. 05. 9 Long. 171. 20. 9

Sunday Feb. the 28th
Commences with strong breezes from S & heading N. at 6
wore ship to the S & under short sail middle latter part
strong gales with rain. so ends.

Monday March the 1st
Commences with strong gales from the E with rain heading
S & E under a main top sail & fore spinnaker at 6. wore ship
to the N N E.
Latt. 23. 14

Tuesday March the 2nd
Commences with strong gales from the E heading N N E
latter part more moderate at 6. wore ship to the S & E so ends
Latt. 23. 12. 9 Long. 174. 09. 9
