Tuesday March the 16th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading E
under short sail Middle & latter part the same so ends
Lat. 26. 18. 29

Wednesday March the 17th
Commences with strong gales from S.E. heading E at 6 P.M.
saw ship to the N.W. Middle & latter part the same
Lat. 26. 21

Thursday March the 18th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading
N.E. latter part hard squalls of rain so ends

Friday March the 19th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading E
with squalls of rain latter part wind E heading E
so ends

Saturday March the 20th
Commences with hard gales from the S.E. heading E
Middle & latter part more moderate but the fore sail
Lat. 25. 20. 2 Long. 160. 06. 6

Sunday March the 21st
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading E
bent a fore top, most stay sail latter part winds S.W.
heading S.E. at 11 tacked to the N. so ends
Lat. 25. 42 Long. 160. 46. 6

Monday March the 22nd
Commences with pleasant breeze from the S.E. heading W.S.W. at 10
tacked ship to the E. saw fin backs so ends
Lat. 25. 52 Long. 160. 09

Tuesday March the 23rd
Commences with pleasant breeze from the S.E. heading E
at 6 P.M. tacked ship to the W.S.W. so ends
Lat. 25. 58 Long. 160. 24

Wednesday March the 24th
Commences with pleasant breeze from the S.E. heading W.S.W.
Middle part the same latter part when the watch employed in turning
up the rigging so ends
Lat. 26. 15. 9

Thursday March the 25th
Commences with a calm latter part light breeze from the S.E.
staying E. employed in rigging at 11. saw ship to the S.W.
Lat. 26. 45 Long. 160. 40. 6

Friday March the 26th
Commences with light breeze from the S.E. heading E.S.E.
Middle & latter part the same saw pumps so ends

Saturday March the 27th
Commences with light breeze from the S.E. heading E.S.E.
Middle part the same latter part to the S.W. so ends
Lat. 26. 10 Long. 160. 10. 6

Sunday March the 28th
Commences with strong breeze from S.E. heading S.W. at 3
tacked to the E.S.E. latter part strong gales so ends
Lat. 25. 52. 9

Monday March the 29th
Commences with strong gales from the S.E. heading E.S.E. under
short sail saw killer Middle & latter part the same so ends
Lat. 26. 23. 6
