

Remarks on board of the Ship. William Hamilton May, 18th

Tuesday, April the 25th
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. steering N.W.
at 1. saw sperm whales lowered the boats & returned in starboard
& waist boats eye each took them along side Middle part lay by
heading S.W. latter part - but them in & began to look steering N.E.

Wednesday April the 26th
Commences with moderate breeze from the S.E. steering to the N.
at 1. H. saw Co. coast Island Middle part heading S.W. off
shore at 4. finished boiling latter part heading in for the land
Lat. 16.34 S.

Thursday April the 27th
Commences with light breeze from the S.E. land in sight
to the windward Middle & latter part light breeze so ends

Friday April the 28th
Commences with light breeze from the S.E. at 1. several barrels
can of from Co. nut Island with shells Middle & latter
part heading off & on shore trading with the natives saw few birds

Saturday May the 1st ~~Wednesday April the 29th~~
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. lying under the
lee of the land Middle & latter part steering to the S.E. so ends
Lat. 17.15 S.

Sunday May the 2nd
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. heading N.E.
Middle & latter part the same so ends. No obs. this day.

Monday May the 3rd
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. heading N.E. Middle
latter part the same. with squalls of rain so ends

Lat. 18.56 S. Long. 172.34 E

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Tuesday May the 4th
Commences with strong breeze from the S.E. heading S.E.
Middle part the same latter part - calm so ends
Lat. 19.01

Wednesday May the 5th
Commences with a calm Middle & latter part light breeze
from the S.E. heading S.E. so ends
Lat. 19.34 Long.

Thursday May the 6th
Commences with light breeze from the S.E. heading S. Middle part N.E.
latter part S by E. saw branches with hard squalls of rain so ends

Friday May the 7th
Commences with strong breeze from the S. heading S by E. with squalls
of rain Middle & latter part to the N.E. under double reefed by each
& main sail so ends.

Lat. 19.22 S. Long. 172.22 West.

Saturday May the 8th
Commences with strong gale from the S.E. heading S.E. at 1. light
& spunkier latter part squalls of rain at 4. tacked ship to the S. so ends

Lat. 19.10 S. Long. 172.34 S.

Sunday May the 9th
Commences with strong breeze from the S. heading S.E. Middle
& latter part the same with squalls of rain so ends.

Lat. 19.14 S.

Monday May the 10th
Commences with strong breeze from the S. heading S.E. at 1. tacked
ship heading N.E. latter part tacked to the S.E.

Lat. 19.23 S. Long. 172.38
