

Remarks on board of the Ship William Hamilton May. 1841

Thursday May the 11th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading S by E latter
part moderate tacked ship to the N E so Ends
Lat. 15. 17. Long. 178. 20. W

Thursday May the 12th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the E heading S by E,
at 6. saw some islands so Ends.
Lat. 14. 17. 9. Long. 178. 20. W.

Thursday May the 13th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading S by E on heading
for Spain, took 4 men to carry to Wallis's Island to save the crew
hies for fear of being killed by the natives so Ends

Friday May the 14th
Commenced with light breezes from the E at 4. left the Island
heading N E by N, Middle & latter part winds variable with light
rain about in light so Ends

Saturday May the 15th
Commenced with light breezes from the E heading S by E latter
part winds from the E tacked ship, half heading S by E so Ends.
Lat. 13. 26

Sunday May the 16th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading S by E Middle &
latter part light breezes latter part tacked to the N so Ends
Lat. 12. 22, Long. 178. 59. W. 1

Monday May the 17th
Commenced with light breezes from the E by E at 6. tacked ship to the S E
latter part calm so Ends. Lat. 13. 56.

Tuesday May the 18th
Commenced with a calm Middle part the same latter part light breezes from the
N Course S by E latter part light breezes so Ends.

Wednesday May the 19th
Commenced with light breezes from the E Course S by E at 6
P.M. saw Wallis's Island at 11. Came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water
in company with the barque Charmer of Sydney. so Ends with
strong breezes.

Wednesday June the 1st
Commenced with moderate breezes from the E at 6. P.M. weighed
anchor & went to sea latter part light breezes so Ends with
plenty of hogs & fowls

Thursday June the 2nd
Commenced with light breezes from the E heading W, Middle part
to the N E, latter part Calm so Ends
Lat. 12. 48

Friday June the 3rd
Commenced with a calm Middle part the same latter part light
breezes from the E steering to the N E so Ends.
Lat. 13. 16. 9

Saturday June the 4th
Commenced with light breezes from the E heading S by E
Middle & latter part strong breezes so Ends
Lat. 13. 44. 9.

Sunday June the 5th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E steering S by E
Middle & latter part - The same so Ends
Lat. 9. 14. 9.
Long. 173. 43. W.

Monday June the 6th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading S by E
latter part equally with rain wind from the N E tacked ship to the S by E

Tuesday June the 7th
Commenced with light breezes from the N E heading S by E latter part
equally heading to the N E so Ends.
Lat. 8. 31. 9
