Friday March the 11th
Commenced with hard gales from N.W. steering E. Middle & by I. latter more moderate made sail wind S.W. steering E. I. & the watch employed in putting the cross jack yard so ends.

Saturday March the 12th
Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. steering E. I. & at 5: sent up the cross jack; gave Middle took in the top gall's sail latter set them with top mast & top gall's sheeting sail & Main Topping so ends.

Lat. 48. 33. S. Long. 147. 10. West

Sunday March the 13th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.W. steering E. I. & with all sail set. with light squalls of rain latter the same so ends.

Lat. 49. 38. S. Long. 133. 50. West

Monday March the 14th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.W. steering E. by I. with all sail set. Latter S.W. with strong breezes from the West. with sheeting sail & set below gall's
Lat. 50. 58. S. Long. 140. 06. West

Tuesday March the 15th
Commenced with strong breezes from the West steering E. I. & with all sail set. Middle & latter E by I. latter light breezes from S.W. so ends.

Lat. 51. 57. S. Long. 136. 11. West

Wednesday March the 16th
Commenced with light breezes from the West steering E. by I. Middle & latter light air from N.W. to S.W. so ends.

Thursday March the 17th
Commenced with light air from the S.W. steering E. by I. the watch employed in taking up the sheeting Middle Calm latter fresh breezes from the West steering E. with all sail set.

Friday March the 18th
Commenced with fresh breezes from the West steering E. Middle & latter light squalls of rain with fog sheeting sail & below & aloft so ends.

Saturday March the 19th
Commenced with fresh breezes from the West steering E. Middle took in sheeting sail & Main top gall's sail & top double reefed both fore & Main top sail latter made sail wind S.W. so ends.

Lat. 53. 42. S. Long. 123. 26. West

Sunday March the 20th
Commenced with fresh gales from the S.W. steering East at 6 double reefed the top sail Middle & latter more moderate with light squalls of rain made sail so ends.

Lat. 54. 10. S. Long. 118. 02. West

Monday March the 21st
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.W. steering E. at 2. A.M. ran on Island of Jeju thick weather Middle strong breezes latter hard squalls of hail & snow from the S. so ends.

Lat. 54. 34. S. Long. 112. 52. West

Tuesday March the 22nd
Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. steering E. by I. Middle & latter strong gales from the S.W. leading E. & under double reefed top & sail with snow squalls so ends.

Lat. 53. 58. S. Long. 108. 40. West

Wednesday March the 23rd
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.W. leading E. by I. Middle moderate steering E. latter fresh breezes from the West all sail set so ends.
