Thursday, March the 24th

Commenced with fresh breezes from the N. steering S. with all sail set standing
sails below & aloft at 2. took in sail strong breeze with rain Middle heavy
squalls, double reefed the top sail latter more moderate wind S. E. heading S. by E.
Made sail so ends

Friday, March the 25th

Commenced with moderate breezes from the S. steering S. Middle & latter strong
breezes from the S. W. so ends

Lat. 15.15 S. Long. 79.34

Saturday, March the 26th

Commenced with strong breezes from the S. W. steering S. Middle &
latter strong gales & hard squalls so ends

Lat. 16.15 S. Long. 80.22 West

Sunday, March the 27th

Commenced with strong gales & hard squalls from the S. W. steering S. by E.
Middle & latter more moderate winds West so ends

Lat. 16.50 S. Long. 80.00 West

Monday, March the 28th

Commenced with strong breezes from the West with squalls of hail. Steering S. by E.
Middle & latter the same so ends

Lat. 16.50 S. Long. 79.10 West

Tuesday, March the 29th

Commenced with strong breezes from the West steering S. E. plenty of
hail & snow Middle the same latter light breezes so ends

Lat. 17.31 S. Long. 78.34 West

Wednesday, March the 30th

Commenced with light breezes from the West steering S. E. latter strong breezes from N. W.
so ends

Lat. 18.52 S. Long. 78.18 West

Thursday, March the 31st

Commenced with strong breezes from S. W. steering S. by E. Middle hard gales with
rain took in the fore & main top sails & fore reefed the main latter light breezes
from the N. Made sail so ends

Lat. 19.15 S. Long. 78.21 West

Friday, April the 1st

Commenced with light breezes from the N. with light rain heading S. by E.
Middle & latter strong gales from S. W. to W. W. with hard squalls double reefed
the top sail so ends steering S. E.

Lat. 19.40 S. Long. 78.21 West

Saturday, April the 2nd

Commenced with strong gales from the N. steering S. E. under double reefed top sails
Middle wind from the N. heading S. E. latter breeze & winds variable with rain so ends

Lat. 19.38 S. Long. 78.22 West

Sunday, April the 3rd

Commenced with strong breezes from the N. W. steering S. by E. Middle & latter
strong gales from the West so ends with hard squalls

Lat. 19.33 S. Long. 78.32 West

Monday, April the 4th

Commenced with strong gales from N. W. steering S. by E. Middle wind N. W.
latter strong gales from the West so ends

Lat. 19.06 S. Long. 78.53 West

Tuesday, April the 5th

Commenced with strong gales from the West steering S. by E. Middle hard gales
from the S. W. took in all sail but a fore reefed. Main top sail & fore sail steering
N. E. latter more moderate. Made sail steering S. E. saw a brig steering the same so ends
