Sunday, May, the 1st
Commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering N.W. by W. with all sail set
Middle & latter variable winds with rain & ends. No Observation.

Monday, May, the 2^d
Commences with variable winds & rain Course S.W. by W. Middle & latter the
same Course N. No Observation, this Day

Tuesday, May, the 3^d
Commences with variable winds & rain Course S. Middle the same latter
More pleasant & calm & ends. Lat. 1.40. S.

Wednesday, May, the 4th
Commences with light breeze from the W. heading N. at 5. backed wind from
the N. heading W. at 6. saw a brig steering to the N.W. latter
Variable wind with rain & ends. No Observation.

Thursday, May, the 5th
Commences with light breezes & variable with rain heading S.W. the brig
in sight at 5. backed ship heading W. Middle calm, latter light breezes from N.W. heading
W. & ends. Lat. 1.19. S. Long. 39.30. W.

Friday, May, the 6th
Commences with light breezes from N.W. heading S.W. Middle & latter
the same & ends. Lat. 00.4. S.

Saturday, May, the 7th
Commences with light breezes from N.W. steering N.W. by W. Middle
W.W. by W. latter squalls from the S. with rain, No Obs. this Day.

Sunday, May, the 8th
Commences with light breezes from the N.W. steering N.W. by W.
Middle & latter moderate breezes steering N.W. & ends.
Lat. 00.47. North
Long. 41.40. West

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Monday, May, the 9th
Commences with moderate breezes from the N.E. steering N.W. with
all sail set - Middle & latter strong breezes with squalls of rain & ends.

Tuesday, May, the 10th
Commences with strong breezes from the W. steering N.W. the watch
employed in setting the 1st Mast - rigging. Middle the same & ends.
Middle split the fore top sail at daylight - sent an other, Lat. 4.05. N. Long.

Wednesday, May, the 11th
Commences with strong breezes from N.W. steering N.W. the watch
employed in repairing stanchions. latter the same & ends.
Lat. 6.10. N. Long. 37.00. West

Thursday, May, the 12th
Commences with strong breezes from N.W. steering N.W. at 5. backing
the studding Bores & studd. N.W. by W. Middle the same & ends.
Lat. 8.12. N. Long. 34.45. W.

Friday, May, the 13th
Commences with strong breezes from the N.W. heading S.W. Middle &
latter steering N.W. by W. wind S.W. the watch employed in
taring down & ends.
Lat. 10.04. N. Long. 32.28. W.

Saturday, May, the 14th
Commences with fresh breezes from the N.W. steering N.W. by W.
Middle & latter part the same & ends. Lat. 12.34. N. Long. 29.16. West

Sunday, May, the 15th
Commences with strong breezes from N.W. steering N.W. by W. Middle
light breezes latter strong all sail set & ends.
Lat. 14.44. N. Long. 26.52. W.
