June 11 1865

Thick fog suppose the ship to be off the Yamsky rocks got the anchors off the bow bent the cables so commenced my N.E. gulf sea soon got one seaman of duty sick with rheumatism as something else gave him 3 doses of perly davis

June 15 1865 ship at anchor of the sand spit calm and thick fog corpses employed sitting up about rather dull times at present but I hope there is better coming

June 16 1865 ship off diamond beach strong gale from N.E. saw nothing but hip racks ship working up the gulf in hopes to find the whales last night anchored off the East End of the sand spit at 10 evening commenced to blow called all hands to take the anchors at 6 morning find we have quinned up the gulf about 15 miles

June 17 all these 24 hours strong breeze from N.E. ship of dinges reef saw nothing 2 boats in shore at noon took up the boat ship the later part heading for the tongue land

June 19 strong S.W. gale with fog later part anchored in S.W. harbor in 20 fathoms water 2 miles from land 2 boats off saw nothing

June 20 blowing a gale from S.W. got under way found the weather so coarse anchored again in S.W. bay that much of it sheltered

June 21 blowing a heavy gale from S.W. with heavy swell at 10 it got under way to get closer the shore at 1 P.M. anchored with my heavy anchor the boats head land bearing S.S.W. distant 1 mile the shore bearing N.W. distant 5 of a mile put my cutting tatted on the cable and tripped the windlass falls barometer showed at 29.5

June 27 fine weather ship off long island saw several whales very shy 3 boats chasing with it luck

July 1 1865 ship of sand rock saw 2 whales lower 4 boats got a small whale

July 2nd blowing a gale from the south west ship of sand rock saw nothing ship started for long rock
