Most of these 24 hours light baffling winds with fog
Ship off S W bay saw several whales at 9 P.M. saw
boat struck at 11 got the whale to the ship at 12 commenced
cutting several sail in sight

Two

Wednesday 12 1865 first part light S W wind
with squalls of fog at 4 A.M. saw whales of Sunday
sailed lowered 2 boats at 8 A.M. what boat struck
at 11 A.M. commenced got the whale to the ship at
12 commenced butling at 3 P.M. finished later part strong
S W wind with fog. Back flares in sight cutting

Sunday July 16

blowing a gale from S W ship of Amherst Island
saw nothing employed stowing down oil
had heavy S W gales for the last 4 days

Monday July 31 1865

all these 24 hours light S W wind
with fog ship off S W bay at 8 gulf
at this date we have 9 whales stowed down 200
barrels of oil

Remarks Friday Aug 9 1865

ship off Amherst Island saw whales lowered
4 boats lowered boat struck stows the
boat and hurt the tug too. first officer
lost the whale
