Remarks Tuesday November 3 1864

all there 24 Light South by E. S. S. with
Sun Ship Working to the southeast
the Watch Employed washing ship out side
put by obs 29.5.2 on
long by obs 156.57
the George Howland In sight

Dec 23 1864 on Board Ship enward Bound home
to be there the first of May Next I hope to get some
oil before that time But Whales seems to be very
scarce and of strange country to me I have stored the oil
In the New South Pacific In the Prospect don't look
any to Bright But weather I have the oil at it I shall
leave the first of February for home and before if I can
get 100 Barrels of oil I have taken 75 bbls of sperm
Since leaving Honolulu with 10 worth 3600 dollars
my share is worth 300 dollars and my wages 100 dollars per month
gives me 400 dollars for the first month on Board the onward

Remarks Friday February 22 1864

at this date I have 180 barrels of oil and with 40 days sail
of home hope to get there by the 15 of April but at present I
strong head winds and I can't tell how long they will last
put by obs 30.23.0 Long 46.43.2
