Sunday Nov 25 1866 fresh N & trades ship steering South Under Quads and employed hauling here to start 24 barrels of fresh water
Latt by obs 16 49 N
Long by bble 158 34 W

Monday Nov 26 1866

all these 24 barrels light N & trades finished hauling. Whales make about 45 barrels ship steering 2 by 2 by compass all sail set
Latt by obs 14 42 N
Long by bble 159 15 W

Tuesday Nov 27 1866

all these 24 barrels light Easterly wind steering 2 by 2 all sail set the watch variously employed nothing beyond making of stowing had some heavy squalls saw a few boobies
Latt by obs 11 52 N
Long by bble 159 30 W

Wednesday Nov 28 1866

all these 24 barrels light Easterly wind with rain steering 2 by 2 all sail set
Latt by obs 9 42 N
Long by bble 159 45 West

Thursday Nov 29 1866 all these 24 barrels squally but with strong SE wind part of the time watch employed repairing main royal

Latt by obs 7 32 N
Long by bble 160 32 W

Friday Nov 30 1866 all these 24 barrels fresh Easterly wind steering South by compass passed close to Washington Island saw smoke on shore and the bottom under the ship 2 miles from shore nothing of land sight

Saturday Dec 1 1866 fore part of these 24 barrels calm latter part strong Easterly wind with rain steering 2 by 2 by compass all sail set cleaned and white washed the fore castle

Sunday Dec 2 all these 24 barrels fresh SE trades steering S by W all sail set ship's drift sail as Latt 1 12 N

Monday Dec 3 1866

all these 24 barrels light S & trades with pleasant weather steered down and sperm oil 45 barrels took down the sail pen to make room
Latt 1 06 S
Long 163 34 W

Tuesday Dec 4 all these 24 barrels light Easterly wind steering South by compass set fore top mast steering sail had the officers take meat heads

Wednesday Dec 5 1866

with rain all these 24 barrels fresh Easterly wind with rain the watch variously employed
Latt 6 06 S
Long by sext 164 45 W all Well

Thursday Dec 6 1866

fore part of these 24 barrels Easterly wind latter part calm with S by W
Latt 8 41 S
Long 165 02 W

Friday Dec 7 1866 fore part calm latter part light N & wind steering South by compass at 4 P.M. saw the same Island found it 30 miles East of where it is laid down on the chart
