Tuesday March 10th

Light breeze from S. East Steering W. by N. at 4 PM Lat by Obs 54. 40

Wednesday March 11th (Capt Wm. Rissbeck) Wind and weather the same as on the preceding day. Ship Lord Maitland 56 days from Liverpool for New Orleans in want of water. Supplied them with 512 and 1000 left them. Lat by Obs 19 43 Long by Ch 58. 40

Thursday March 12th

Wind from N. E. squally heading W. West very Rugged Ship a great deal of water. Lat by Obs 21. 00 Long by 56. 20

Friday March 13th

Buffed weather heading W. West sent Dr. to leeward heading same as ourselves. Lat by Obs 22 7 00 Long by Ch 58 12 00

Saturday March 14th

All these twenty four hours strong breeze from E. S. E. Steering W. West passed 3 different vessels during the day. Most of them Steering West. Lat by Obs 24. 00 Long by Ch 60. 10 W

Sunday March 15th

Weather more boating heavy swell from N. E. Steering W. by N. Lat by Obs 25. 10 Long by Ch 61. 18 W

Monday March 16th

Mostly Calm throughout the day Steering W. West latter part light air from S. S. West. Lat by Obs 25. 40 Long by Ch 61. 56

Tuesday March 17th

Begins moderate from S. West and very fine weather Steering W. West latter part strong breeze at 4 AM then wind changed to the N. West hall a smart squall of rain. Lat by Obs 27. 20 Long by Ch 62. 00 W

Wednesday March 18th

Fresh Gales from W. West heading W. East high sea on at 10 AM more to the S. West. Lat by Obs 28 16 Long by Ch 62 00 W

Thursday March 19th

Fresh Gales from W. West - quite squally heading W. S. West high sea on. Lat by Obs 27. 10 Long by Ch 63 20

Friday March 20th

Moderate from S. West heading W. by South at 2 PM passed a three masted Steam Ship Steering North. Lat by Obs 27. 10 Long by Ch 64. 10

Saturday March 21st

Being the same as on the preceding day heading West. Lat by Obs 27 08 Long by Ch 66 00

Sunday March 22nd

Wind and weather continues same from W. by N. Steering W. by South. Lat by Obs 26 40 Long by Ch 67 20 W

Monday March 23rd

Moderate from W. S. West Great Swell on heading W. by N. West saw large quantities of S. S. West. Lat by Obs 26 54 Long by Ch 68. 31 W
