Friday March 28th

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. this
forenoon Employed in clearing away the Whale Heads and
Commenced Boiling the Biggy Clifford Kitt in eight
Employed in Boiling heading to the Southward and
Eastward under Single reefed Top Sail Lewis Toss
Still Sick.

Lat 14-07 N Long 43-56 W
Saturday March 30th

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from E.N.E. with
good Weather cruising under Main Top Gallant Sail
Heading N at 12 Sailed Ship heading S.E. saw some
farmers also a Sail Employed in Boiling at 10 P.M.
Finished Boiling Lewis Toss and Michael Silen Sick.

Lat 14-03 N Long 43-51 W
Sunday March 31st

This Day Commenced with a light breeze from E.N.E. heading
S.E. at 1 A.M. over Ship heading N.N.E. the Biggy Clifford
Kitt in eight saw nothing of Note Lewis Toss Still Sick.

Lat 14-15 N Long 43-31 W
Monday Apr. 1st

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from E. Steering to the
Wind heading S by E Employed in Moving Down Pit L.
Nothing of Note Lewis Toss Still Sick.

Lat 14-28 N Long 43-32 W

Tuesday April 2nd

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from E.N.E. Steering
to the Westward and Westward. Saw one Sail the sunset
Employed in Working Ship inside good Weather and all
Sail set at 6 P.M. Shortened Sail Lewis Toss still
Sick.

Lat 14-13 N Long 43-42 W
Wednesday April 3rd

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from E.N.E.
at 6 A.M. kept off Steering to the Westward the sunset
Employed in Working Ship outside saw nothing of Note
Lewis Toss still sick at 6 P.M. Looped to the
wind heading S.E.

Lat 14-22 N Long 46-22 W
Thursday April 4th

This Day Commenced with a light breeze from E.N.E.
at 6 A.M. kept off Steering N.W. Employed in heading
the Sails and Pointing the Ship right saw Nothing
Lewis Toss Still Sick.

Lat 14-23 N Long 47-23 W
Friday April 5th

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from E. Steering
N by N with good Weather some Black. Tied the Weather
Employed in Making several Mats and Springers.
Lewis Toss still Sick.
