Saturday Apr. 6th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from E. Steering W under
Main Top Sails. Sail the watch Employed in Ship Duty.
Saw nothing of No. Lewis F. Fox still sick.

Lat 14-08 N Long 50-50 W
Sunday Apr. 7th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from E. Steering W by S
at 3 P.M. Mrs. Pomer raised Spinn Whales going quick
to Windward made all sail and beat to windward per.
Main till Dark but did not gain of the Whales any
at Dark shortened sail and stood along by the Wind
under Top Sail full and Spinnaker heading N by E Lewis
Fox still sick.

Lat 18-46 N Long 52-46 W
Monday April 8th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from N by E by the
wind at 12 M kept off Steering W by N the Watch Employed
in Beating out for Water. Saw nothing of No. Lewis
Fox still sick.

Lat 18-14 N Long 52-45 W
Tuesday April 9th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from E Steering W
the Watch Employed in Steering of Top Sails. Raising some
jumps. also a sail Lewis Fox still sick.

Lat 18-30 N Long 51-33 W

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Wednesday April 10th

This Day Commences with a light air from E Steering
W by S Employed in Raising the Mizen Rigging and making
springing one. Sail in sight at 12 M a Calm Lewis F.
Fox still sick.

Lat 18-34 N Long 53-37 W

Thursday April 11th

This Day Commences with a Calm at 2 P.M. a light breeze
from N by E Steering W by S one. Sail in sight. Light-
squash of rain. Employed in Raising the Mizen Rigging
and Making Broad Water. Lewis Fox still sick.

Lat 18-15 N Long 56-00 W

Friday April 12th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from N by E with
rain squashed Steering West by S at 12 M Steering W by N
the Watch Employed in Ship Duty. Saw nothing of
No. Lewis Fox still sick. Captain Robinson made
some more paper.

Lat 18-52 N Long 57-33 W

Saturday April 13th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from E Steering W all hands working
5. M. 1 sail in sight at 2 O'Clock P.M. saw Barbadoes one of
the West India Island at 3 P.M. by making the Buggy Day Light
of New Haven at 6 P.M. hoisted the Top Sails and
Main Sail the Island of Barbadoes bearing West 10 Miles
Distant.
