 Sunday April 11th

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. running down the Sound at 6 A.M. got up the Chain and Beat them on to the Anchors and got the Anchor off the Bow at 10 A.M. Drifted Anchor in Barbadoes fished the Tack and Cleared up. At 12 the Captain and his Wife and Children went on Shore at 6 P.M. and returned for Board at 8 P.M.

Monday April 12th

Lying at Anchor in Barbadoes. Employed in painting the Cabin around the Ship and Boat. Hoys and Bowsprit. Shrouds the Barbadoes and some of the crew on Shore at night. Anchor Watch.

Tuesday April 13th

Lying at Anchor in Barbadoes at 6 A.M. took two Anchors in to the Shore and stood out of the harbor at 8 A.M. Captain Robinson and Wife went on Shore the Ship Lying off on on at 2 P.M. the Captain came of Board kept off Steady N.W. by N.W. & with a Steady breeze from E. with all Tack set

Wednesday April 14th

This Day Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. Steady N.W. by N.W. at 6 A.M. Lars Matheson at 3 P.M. Drifted Anchor in Dominica fished the Tack and closed up the Tack at Night. Anchor Watch

 Thursday April 18th

Lying at Anchor in Dominica Employed in Laying up the Head Hoys Main Hoys and Main Top Mast. Tack and Tacking Down Raising Fore and Aft and Tacking with the Natives for Food and game at Night. all Hands on Shore till 9 O'Clock but the Anchor Watch

Friday April 19th

Lying at Anchor in Dominica Employed in Tacking Down Raising Laying up the Fore and Aft. Hoys at the Main and Mizen and Pumping the Ship. Chain Rod at Night. Anchor Watch

Saturday April 20th

Lying at Anchor in Dominica Employed in Tacking Down and Pumping Ship. Out. Tack at Night. Anchor Watch. Edward Cobb Sick

Sunday April 21st

Lying at Anchor in Dominica all Hands on Shore but the Anchor Watch at 10 the Bark *Para* of New Bedford came in and anchored at 2 P.M. all Hands on Board. Cobb on Duty again. Richard found the man that stood away on board of us when we sailed from New Bedford and shipped with us in Barbadoes Decided and also married. Decided while on Shore at Night. Anchor Watch
