sailing under Fly Jib and Main Top Sails. Sail
Employed in Breasting out for Water and Rain
Saw a school of Porpoise at 7 P.M. Shattered Sail

Thursday May 23rd

This Day Commences with a Calm at 12 M. a light air from
N heading to the Westward. Employed in Ship Duty
Saw a school of Porpoise at 7 P.M.

Lat 29-58 N Long 52-54 W

Friday May 24th

This Day Commences with a Calm at 7 A.M. a light breeze from
S. by E heading W. sailing under Fly Jib and Main Top Sails.
Employed in Bristling the mast in the Starboard Boat -
and the Line Tubs saw a school of Porpoise at 7 P.M.
Single reefed the Top Sail fished the Jib and Spinnaker

Saturday May 25th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from W. sailing to -
the Westward under Fly Jib and Main Top Sails.
at 12 P.M. Steering N.E. saw a few Black Fish and Porpoise
at 7 P.M. Shattered Sail and Leached to the Wind
Hosae C. Nash sick and off Duty

Sunday May 26th 1878

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from the heading N
at 8 A.M. Shift of Steering S.E. at 7 P.M. Leached to -
the Wind heading S. under Single reefed Top Sails, saw
a school of Porpoise. Hosae C. Nash and Henry Johnson
sick

Lat 30-07 N Long 54-06 W

Monday May 27th

This Day Commences with a fine breeze from the heading S by W
at 6 A.M. Made Sail Steering by the Wind heading S by W
Employed in Bristling the Mast in the Main Boat and
Reefing the Top Mast and Top Sails. Mast at 7 P.M.
Shattered Sail saw nothing of Note. Hosae Nash still Sick

Lat 29-08 N Long 53-33 W

Tuesday May 28th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from the S by W
heading S at 5 A.M. Made Sail. Saw two Sick Employed
in Breasting out for Water and Painted Ship in Fore
at 7 P.M. Shattered Sail Hosae C. Nash and
Henry Johnson still Sick

Lat 28-19 N Long 53-26 W

Wednesday May 29th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from S. by W with a set
to the sailing under all Sail saw one Sail Hosae Nash on Duty
a gun at 7 P.M. Took in the Light - saw one heading S. by E

Lat 28-21 N Long 52-55 W
