 Wednesday Sept. 18th

This Day Commenced with a light variable wind and Calm
 fore Sail in Sight at 5 A. M. Saw Rio one of the Western
 Islands at 3 P. M. a light breeze from E. Strong S.
 at 4 P. M. the Island of Foyah Bearing S. 25 Miles
 distant. the Watch to work in the Rigging, saw a
 New Wheel rope at Night working the Ship up to the
 Island of Foyah.

Thursday Sept. 19th

This Day Commenced with a light breeze and Calm
 working the Ship up to the General fine Sail in
 Sight. the watch to work on Rigging at 4 P. M. a
 fine breeze from N. S. W. heading S. S. E. at 6 P. M.
 the West End of Foyah Bearing S. by E. and the
 East End Bearing S. W. by S. 20 Miles distant at Night.
 Standing off and on the General

Friday Sept. 20th

This Day Commenced with a light breeze from S. S. E.
 Beating up to Foyah on opposite tack to the Gun a number
 of Sails also a Steamer standing in for the land the watch
 Employed in Ship's Duty, at 6 O'clock P. M. the South
 End of Foyah at Point Point Bearing S. by E.
 and the North Point Bearing N. W. E. 6 Miles distant
