

Remarks on Board Bark Boston of New Bedford Mass 1878  
Monday Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>

Lying at anchor in Foul. The Cooper Employed in getting up Shooks the Watch Employed in Stowing the Coffee. Took sent a Cook of Malacca <sup>1364</sup> on Board the Bark Palmetto of New Bedford. The Steward Watch a Shore on Liberty Lane Custom House Office on board the Cooper from there to work on Board of us.

Tuesday Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>  
Lying at anchor in Foul. Employed in getting up Shooks and Stowing the Coffee. During Weather at Night - anchor Watch during heavy all night - two Custom House Office on Board the Cooper to work from there.

Wednesday Oct. 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Lying at anchor in Foul. Morning a Sale of Wood with some at 2 P.M. it - stopped raining. Employed in Stowing the Coal at Night - anchor Watch with two Custom House Office on Board the Cooper from Shuck's work on Board of us to day.

Thursday Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Lying at anchor in Foul. Employed in getting up Shooks and Stowing the Coffee. The Cooper and the Hepfille took at 11 AM took a Bullwhisk on Board and killed him. The Cooper from there to work to day a Heavy breeze with some squalls. To Custom House Office in board. F. W. Henderson went on there and Gen. a Doctor and get some Medicine for a lame horse at Night. anchor Watch.

Remarks on Board Bark Boston of New Bedford Mass 1878  
Friday Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>

Lying at anchor in Foul. Employed in Stowing the Coal and the Cooper from there getting up Shooks and Coopers. Board and then Joseph Magwood came on Board this morning and went on duty again. F. W. Henderson a Shore with a lame horse at Night. The Port watch on there anchor Watch at Night. The Cooper with sick in the Hospital.

Saturday Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>  
Lying at anchor in Foul. Employed in Stowing the Coal. Port Watch and the Cooper from there getting up Shooks for Water. F. W. Henderson the Mail - at the Foul Hotel on there with a lame horse and the Doctor attending him. Took some Wood on Board and sent some Coal on there for Water. Board the Ship and Daged them at Night. anchor Watch the Steward Watch a shore this evening.

Sunday Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>  
Lying at anchor in Foul. some of the Crew on there. The Mail Steamer came in to day at Night - anchor Watch. Charles Williams and Albert Johnson did not come on Board to day.
