

Remains on Board Bark Borthon off New Bedford
Tuesday Oct 13th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the N.W. steering by it at about 2 o'clock P.M. split the gill then took in spunkies & sent in gill & put the fore stay sail in the place of it about 3 o'clock commenced too sail & came in thick lock sight off the land & wind hauled her the boat cleared off at 4 o'clock & saw the land bearing W. by N. kept off her at about 12 o'clock lowered the St. Brille light & sent ashore took 3 thick men for medical aid & a boat crew came back & took the boat up & off the thick men went to the Hospital Charles Washburn & Mike Brown 3 men on board sick off Duty. Albert Johnson, Jamine & Arthur Pierce at about 7 o'clock spoke the Bark Vassarica Captain Halloway Boarded her & layal lowered the Starboard Boat went ashore & hoisted came back & took the Boat up at 7 o'clock & kept by the wind & layal bearing N.W. by W. latter part wind light

Monday Oct 14th

This day opens with a light wind from N. & steering by it at daylight broke out the Sail cast took the gill out & stowed it back took the fore stay sail off & put it in its place & sent out the gill & hauled & cast off. Bep & some water about 2 o'clock took the tops out of the topsails and set light sails at 2 o'clock took in light sails & layal bearing N.W. by W. about 12 miles off at 1 o'clock wind hauled N.W. by W. latter part saw a merchant Brig steering about N.E. at 11 o'clock around heading off three

This day opens with a good breeze from the N.W. steering by it laying off & on at layal about 2 o'clock wind died away Captain took out flour & sugar & put the band on the fore mast for the main topsail stay & set it up at 4 o'clock P.M. boat went on shore the being about 5 miles off. continued calm till 7 o'clock P.M. boat came from shore at 8 o'clock hoisted her up and stood by the wind being a good breeze from N.W. by E. ends

Wednesday Oct 16th

This day opens with a strong breeze from N.W. laying off & on at layal at 4 o'clock boat came along side with a man for the ship took some trade & left soon after at 6 o'clock boat went in shore at 11 a.m. shore boat came off with barrels left at 1 o'clock at 3 o'clock the boat came off took her up stood along under double reef topsails put a spunkie & topsails wind increasing at 4 o'clock & commenced too sail and came in thick kept off N.W. by W. took in gill & spunkies. put out fore topsail & closed reef the main at being thick & blowing strong at 5 o'clock P.M. cleared off layal bearing W. by N. by E. by East St. George E.M. & Charles Washburn came on board after his things he being discharged on account of sickness the same 3 men off Duty about 7 o'clock wind hauled her the N.W. it cleared off about 9 o'clock P.M.
