

Remarks On Board Baste Breeze off New Bedford
Monday Jan 9th

This day opens with a good breeze from the N.E. steering W. at daylight seen about the main spencers and at dusk making a larger saw & sails are off the main & whaler spoke her it was the whaler seen coming since leaving Foul Cape. Lagoon came on board. left about 11 o'clock all hands on Duty Lat. 33-22 North Long. 49-17 W. To Bards this day

Tuesday Jan 10th

This day opens with a good breeze from the N.E. steering by it on the S. tack according to the W. saw finbacks & grasshoppers & sails at sunset took in light sails & reefed topsails strong breeze Lat. 33-21 North Long. 49-16 W.

Wednesday Jan 11th

This day opens with a strong breeze from N.E. steering by it on the S. tack heading E. to S. & were around 10 AM then at 12 o'clock wind increasing grasshoppers in sight latter part sailing wind light & light. To end this day

Thursday Jan 12th

This day opens with a strong breeze from N.E. steering by it. At 10 AM thick and plenty of rain with latter part wind light at 1 o'clock wind on the S. tack saw one sail & grasshoppers latter part wind light & good weather. no sight

Remarks On Board Baste Breeze off the River St. Charles Plateau
Friday Jan 13th

This day opens with light wind from W. steering N.E. made all sail saw plenty of grasshoppers & 2 sails watch employed in backing out water. Bread & other provisions Lat. 33-20 N. Long. 49-13 W. To Bards this day

Saturday Jan 14th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. steering N.E. by it at sunrise made sail & watch employed ships duty broke out a cask of food saw one sail & grasshoppers at sunset took in top gallant sails latter part took in all the light sails wind increasing Lat. 33-20 N. Long. 49-13 W. To Bards

Sunday Jan 15th

This day opens with a strong wind from W. steering N.E. by it. first part reefed topsails took in 5th & spencers at about 1 o'clock on the split fore topmast stay sail at 12 o'clock wind lighter made all sail sunset took in top gallant sails wind backed to the S.W. steering by it heading north Lat. 32-20 North Long. 47-45 W. To Bards this day

Monday Jan 16th

This day opens with a strong breeze from E.N.E. steering by it on the S. tack watch employed in ships duty saw several sails all going N.W. at 11 o'clock went on the S. tack heading E. to S. in the fore topmast stay sail but did not work on it. weather thick & raining at sunset saw several sail latter part clear weather

Lat. 30-30 North Long. 47-22 W. To Bards this day
