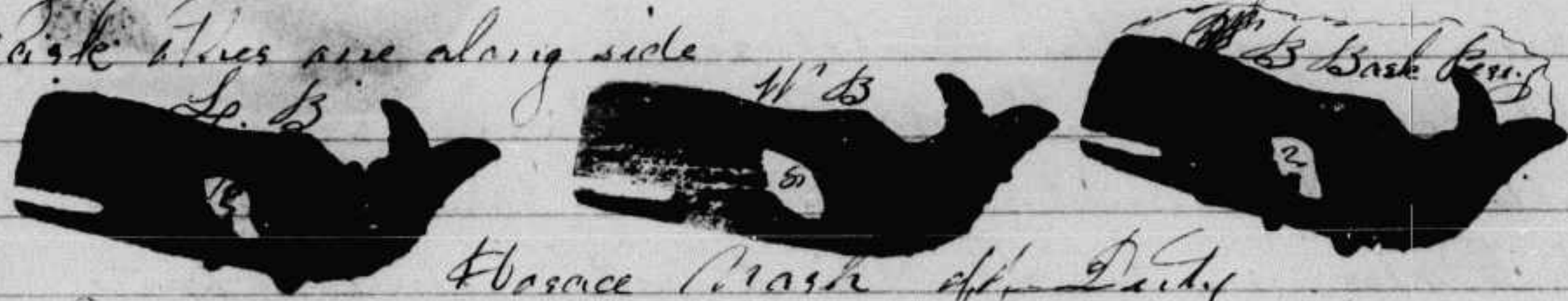


Remarks on Board Bark Bertha of New Bedford
Monday April 29th

This day opens with a strong breeze from N & steering by S.
The Port Tack saw 11 Hets water by 10 arrived too the 11m boats
finished building first part Horace Mash off Duty. Sunset Shortened
Sail 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day

Tuesday April 30th

This day opens with a good breeze steering by S. on the 8th Tack
At 2 o'clock we were assured about sunrise 11 Hets water made
Sail about 2 o'clock spoke her it was the Bark Perry off
Boston. Hickerson Master Capt came on board about
3 o'clock P.M. Saw seven Whales lowered all 3 boats
from each side. Capt. Hickerson went down in the Seaboard
Boat he struck about 11 o'clock then rather boats killed the
whales and took them along side of this vessel these vessels
any more whales they went on board cut 2 of them in before
dark they are along side



Horace Mash off Duty
Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day
Wednesday April 30th

This day opens with a good breeze from N & steering
by it on the 8th Tack with one whale along side at
day light went at work and took him in sent down
the 1000 & 1100. The vessels & 1100 around watch
employed in clearing up the dock at 2 o'clock Barred
with the Perry
Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends

Thursday May 1st

This day opens with a strong breeze from N &
steering by it watch employed in building and oil finished
at 12 o'clock then went too breaking out Hets & provisions
with all hands about 2 o'clock Capt. Hickerson came on
board after his oil let them have 3 casks full as there half -
340 Sullens saw one merchant man at sunset took
in sail Mash off Duty
Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day

Friday May 2nd

This day opens with a good breeze from N & steering
by it on the Port Tack at sunrise made sail & kept
W by N nothing of note in sight but Bark Perry
watch employed in ship's duty at sunset Shortened
Sail Horace Mash off Duty
Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day

Saturday May 3rd

This day opens with a good breeze from N & steering
W by N at day light made all sail & kept W by N
watch working Hets & merchant man in sight
Horace Mash off Duty Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day

Sunday May 4th

This day opens with a light breeze from N & steering
W by N watch idle nothing in sight Mash off Duty
Sun 12:20 M 14:44 = 35° So ends this day
