

Remarks on Board Bark Bertha of New Bedford
Tuesday June 17th

This day opens with a light breeze from the Southward
blowing by the wind on the 1st tack under short sail
at daylight made sail & were around heading N. N. E.
under employed in ships duty at about 1 o'clock P. M.
saw the Galassie up to the main peak & more gallant
head kept up for her sunset took in light sails at
8 o'clock the Bark Perry's boat came along side reported
the Capt. very sick Capt. Robinson went on Board.
Latⁿ 28-18 North Lon^g 52-13 West So ends this day

Wednesday June 18th

This day opens with a light wind from W. Steering
by it. at daylight Capt. came on Board made sail &
kept N. E. the Perry in sight at 7 o'clock P. M. saw this
boat coming for us the Wind made came along side after
Latⁿ 28-37 N. Lon^g 52-22 Capt. Robinson reported Capt.
Dickerson worse Capt. was not able to go the boat left but
came direct back. Then Mr. Briggs went on Board with
them found the Capt. dead he died about 4 o'clock at sunset
took in light sails watch employed in ships duty
So ends this day

Thursday June 19th

This day opens with a light breeze from the South Steering
N. E. at daylight made sail about 6 o'clock the Perry's
boat came along side and brought Mr. Briggs. Mr.
Dickerson came on board but did not sleep long. Mr.
port came latter part light breeze from the S. E.
Steering North Capt. sick Latⁿ 30-02 Lon^g 52-13 W

Robinson Master Bound to Bermuda
Friday June 20th

This day opens with a light breeze from S. E. Steering N. E.
at 4 o'clock P. M. then kept N. N. W. with all sail out
Bark Perry still in sight & saw 2 more sails Capt.
about the same latter part had a good breeze steering
N. W. watch employed in ships duty
Latⁿ 30-19 N. Lon^g 53-03 West So ends this day

Saturday June 21st

This day opens with a fresh breeze from S. E. Steering N. W.
with all sail out the Perry in sight saw another sailing
Bark working to the eastward & 2 more sails watch
employed in washing these clothes. Capt. not much better
Latⁿ 30-22 N. Lon^g 55-05 W. So ends this day

Sunday June 22nd

This day opens with a good breeze from the Southward
Steering W. by N. with all sail out parted the Schooner to
the S. W. saw 2 more sails. May sail. May pick another one
& then sat up the day nothing but one brig in sight
Capt. not much better
Latⁿ 31-44 N. Lon^g 58-02 West So ends this day

Monday June 23rd

This day opens with a strong breeze from S. E. Steering
W. by N. P. M. watch employed in ships duty. Nothing
in sight

Latⁿ 31-50 N. Lon^g 61-12 W. So ends this day
