

Remarks on Board Bark *Beatha of New Bedford*
 Tuesday June 24th

This day opens with a strong breeze from S & steering W by N till 12 o'clock then W N W. Saw the Island of Bermuda about 5 o'clock P.M. bearing N W by W kept for the light house till 7 o'clock. Took in light sails & set top sails & came to the wind heading of Shore N E W.

Lat 32° 00' North Long 69° 29' W at 4 o'clock P.M.

Wednesday June 25th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the N & steering by E laying off Bermuda at 11 o'clock & we kept off for the land wind decreasing & hauled to S E & at about 12 we lowered the Waste Board & Capt. went on shore at 3 o'clock came back Second Mate & crew. Capt. remaining on shore took the boat up and stood along on the S. tack heading E. at 5 o'clock took the reefs out of the top sails wind light at sunset land bearing W by S nearly out of sight. Saw no sail to eyes this day.

Thursday June 26th

This day opens with a good breeze from the W & steering by E at 11 the W. tack at daylight it was quite thick at 6 o'clock it was some lighter & set off N E at 11 P.M. made sail & went on the S. tack heading W by N wind hauled to S E W. nothing in sight of land at sunset shortened sail & were around Lat 33° 02' N Long 69° 04'

Remarks on Board *Beatha of Bermuda*
 Friday June 27th

This day opens with a fine breeze from S W steering by S. at 11 the S. tack one clock were around at sunrise made sail kept off N E at 12 kept W. W. watch employed in Baking and water & provisions at 2 o'clock came to the wind on the S. tack N N W nothing of note in sight. Sunset shortened sail Lat 32° 08' N Long 63° 12' W.

Saturday June 28th

This day opens with a fine breeze from W N W steering by N the S. tack heading about North sunrise made sail watch employed in washing clothes at 12 o'clock went about heading S by W just before sunset saw Blackfish lowered 2 boats. One hit the iron cross and at dark came on board & shortened sail second mate struck the first Lat 33° 52' N Long 63° 42' W so ends this day.

Sunday June 29th

This day opens with a light breeze from the W steering by E at 11 the S. tack at 12 o'clock were ship heading N N W made sail at sunrise were around heading S by E. Saw 2 birds going to the Eastward & saw several sunset took in sail Lat 33° 12' N Long 63° 08' West.
