

Remarks on Board Bark *Beulah* of New Bedford
 Tuesday July 8th

This day opens with a light breeze from the Westward steering
 N. by E. at 3 o'clock wind increased came in Squally at 5 o'clock
 spoke the Schooner *Admiral Blake* & *Thurston* and 35 miles off
 Capt. & wife on shore sick at 10 minutes past 12 o'clock
 saw the Island of Bermuda at 4 o'clock sent the second
 mate on shore with Waste boat came off about dark &
 then stood off shore. So ends this day Light bearing N. by W.

Wednesday July 9th

This day opens with a calm at 3 o'clock had a light breeze
 from N. W. stood in shore at 4 o'clock sent second mate &
 boats crew on shore they returned at one o'clock brought on
 Board Mr. Martin the Misses Mide & The baggage & some
 potatoes & oranges went back & returned about 3 o'clock with
 the Capt. & wife & child took the boat up & made sail
 kept E. by South with a good breeze from N. by W.

Thursday July 10th

This day opens with a good breeze from the N. by W.
 steering E. by S. with all drawing sail out watch employed
 in ships duty Latⁿ 31-45 North Longth 61-05 West So ends this day

Friday July 11th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the Westward steering
 East & E. by N. had a Squally threat of the day watch employed in
 ships duty. Nothing in sight of land. So ends

Robinson master Cruising in the Western Sound
 Saturday July 12th

This day opens with a strong breeze from the West & Squally. Took
 in light sails but soon had them and again except fore top
 gallant sail steering E. by N. till 12 o'clock then kept E. by S.
 watch employed in washing the clothes at sunset shortened
 sail. Latⁿ 32-07 North Longth 54 17 W. So ends

Sunday July 13th

This day opens with a good breeze from N. W. steering E. by N.
 at sunrise made sail at 12 o'clock kept E. by N. nothing in
 sight shortened sail

Latⁿ 31 50 N Longth 51-37 W. So ends this day

Monday July 14th

This day opens with light variable wind at sunrise made
 sail trying to get to Southward watch sent down
 main topsail & repaired it sent it up about 6 o'clock
 sunset shortened sail nothing in sight
 Latⁿ 31-50 North Longth 50-30 W. So ends

Tuesday July 15th

This day opens with a calm but had a light breeze
 ahead of the day from the N. by E. made sail at sunrise
 & sent down the fore topsail repaired it & sent it up about
 2 o'clock at sunset shortened sail nothing in sight
 Latⁿ 31-40 N Longth 50-20 W. So ends this day
