

Remarks on Board Bark Bertha of New Bedford
Tuesday July 22nd

This day opens with a light breeze from the East steering by it on the 1st tack heading N. by E. at sunrise made all sail the same Whaling Boat in sight at daylight watch employed in ships duty. Saw one Merchant Brig. forenoon & forenoon sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 32-09 N Lon 50-00 West So ends this day
Wednesday July 23rd

This day opens with a good breeze from the E. steering by it on the 1st tack heading N. by E. at sunrise made all sail watch employed in ships duty. Saw forenoon & 2 Merchant vessels sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 33-13 North Lon 49-45 W So ends this day
Thursday July 24th

This day opens with a good breeze from the E. & steering by it heading N. by E. at sunrise made all sail watch employed in ships duty. Saw forenoon, grasshoppers & one Brig at sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 34-34 North Lon 48-37 W So ends this day
Friday July 25th

This day opens with a light breeze from N. W. steering by it on the 1st tack at sunrise made all sail & were around heading N. W. by South watch employed in ships duty nothing of note in sight at sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 35-11 N Lon 48-45 W So ends this day

Remarks on Board Cruising on the Western Ground
Saturday July 26th

This day opens with a light breeze from the North steering by it on the 1st tack at day light saw a Whaling Brig close to read her name & address. Made sail saw 2 ships about the same time were around on the 1st tack but they proved to be grasshoppers watch employed in watching these boats
Saw Merchant Brig in sight sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 34-56 N Lon 49-17 W So ends this day
Sunday July 27th

This day opens with light variable wind at sunrise made all sail. Had a light breeze from N. W. steering by it on the 1st tack. Saw one Merchant Brig. Blackbird & grasshoppers latter part had light breeze from N. W. steering by it sunset shortened sail
Latⁿ 34-57 N Lon 49-19 W So ends this day

Monday July 28th

This day opens with a light breeze from the N. W. steering North watch employed in ships duty. Sunrise made all sail nothing of note in sight about sunset saw a Brig steering N. E. shortened sail & kept on the 1st tack
Latⁿ 34-40 North Lon 49-19 W So ends this day

Tuesday July 29th

This day opens with a light breeze from N. W. steering to the North watch employed in ships duty. Sunrise made all sail lowered the White boat and caught a turtle two birds in sight & plenty grasshoppers sunset shortened sail

Latⁿ 34-19 North Lon 49-02 W So ends this day
