 Thursday Oct. 4th

This day opens with a light breeze from the South W. Steering by it on the S. Tack with all sail out heading S & by the point South at sunset the Island of Teneriffe of the S. beam bearing S W. Saw several sails & plenty of grasspurses. So ends this day
 Sunday Oct 5th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. W. Steering by it on the S. Tack heading about S & most of the time saw the Island of St. Michael and on sail at sunset the Island bearing S W by S. saw the light that bearing S by W. Latⁿ 32-23 So ends this day
 Monday Oct 6th

This day opens with a light breeze from S. W. Steering by it with all sail out on the S. Tack heading S & saw the light till 2 o'clock at the at daylight until about 3 o'clock watch employed in ships Duty saw grasspurses & sails Latⁿ 37-57 North So ends this day
 Tuesday Oct 7th

This day opens with a light breeze from South Steering by it on the S. Tack heading from E by S to S & at about 11 o'clock A.M. went about on the S. Tack heading W S W most of the time till 4 o'clock. Then went on the S. Tack S & by E watch employed in ships Duty saw grasspurses Latⁿ 38-26 N. Long 23-10 West

This day opens with a light breeze from the South Steering by it with all sail out on the S. Tack heading S & by the point South had some light squalls. Most of the time went on the S. Tack heading W S W. watch employed in ships Duty saw one steamer & saw sail & grasspurses Latⁿ 38-57 N. Long 23-11 W. So ends this day
 Thursday Oct 9th

This day opens with a calm at daylight saw the Island of St. Marys & on sail watch employed in ships Duty about 4 o'clock at the had a light breeze from the E by S. Steering by it on the S. Tack heading S & saw plenty of grasspurses at sunset the Island bearing W S W Latⁿ 36-40 North Long 23-37 West So ends this day
 Friday Oct 10th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. Steering S & about 11 o'clock A.M. wind hauled to the S W. went on the S. Tack with all sail out watch employed in ships Duty saw 3 merchant vessels & white water but did not make out what it was Latⁿ 36-29 North So ends this day
 Saturday Oct 11th

This day opens with a calm until about 4 o'clock A.M. then had a light breeze from S. W. Steering by it on the S. Tack with all sail out heading about S & watch employed watching these & other sails & steamer Latⁿ 35-55 N. Long 22-33 W. So ends
