working up to the Head of the Island came along side at about 12 o'clock
at 10 o'clock saw after with 30 fathoms of cable pulled sails
then went to washing ship outside & some breaking out the
after hole So ends this day

Saturday Oct. 18th
This day opens with laying at anchor all hands employed
in breaking out oil & co. putting it & stowing in in the after hole
at dark Boatwain took the watches 2 of them So ends

Sunday Oct. 19th
This day opens with laying at anchor at 12 o'clock & in
let the 6 men & boy that came on Board at St. Kitts go
on shore with orders to come if at sunset but they did not
come. The rest of the crew idle So ends this day
