

Remains on Board Bark Beitha of New Bedford
Monday Feb 20th

This day opens with lying at anchor. The 6 men & boy still on shore. The rest of the crew at work breaking out & stowing the hole & coopersing casks for the general store. So ends this day.

Tuesday Feb 21st
This day opens with lying at anchor at day called all hands and went at work breaking out & stowing the hole about sunset. The 6 men came off in charge of two soldiers went to put them in irons but they would not have them as Capt. came off about dark with some more captives when he called them they went down in the forecabin and would not come up so we locked them down there. Capt. went back & had one officer & boatman to stand watch. So ends this day.

Wednesday Feb 22nd
This day opens with lying at anchor at 1 o'clock. Mr. Capt. called the 6 men on deck & put them in irons rest of the crew employed in ship. Duty Mrs. Burgess & the Cook went on shore. The Cook did not come off. So ends this day.

Thursday Feb 23rd
This day opens with lying at anchor. The 6 men in irons. The rest of the crew painting outside the ship. After dinner Mrs. Briggs went on shore came off about sunset. So ends this day.

Friday Feb 24th
This day opens with lying at anchor at 1 o'clock. A Mr. Capt. came on Board & took the 6 men out of irons & they went on duty. The boat came along side & we took 259 lbs of water all hands employed in stowing the hole. Sent 82 lbs of Shakes on Board. The Schooner off. A. Groves. So ends this day.

Saturday Feb 25th

This day opens with lying at anchor called all hands at daylight and cleared up the deck & washed off after dinner Mrs. Briggs, Mr. Washburn, Mr. Bratton, the Steward & George Adams went on shore. All came off at dark but Mrs. Briggs about 10 o'clock & the Misses & the 6 men & the boy John Millett. They had took 2 Wash tubs & 3 chest covers & a bush Boards thought they had 5 men on shore.

So ends this day.

Sunday Feb 26th

This day opens with lying at anchor called all hands at daylight washed off the deck after breakfast one boatman and George Adams & cabin boy went on shore. The Steward went after dinner all came off before dark. So ends this day.

Monday Feb 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor all the crew on board but the messengers about 1 o'clock & Mr. The Shore boat came along side with the boy John Millett. So ends this day.

Tuesday Feb 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor after dinner Mrs. Briggs & her Burgess went on shore about 3 o'clock. Capt. & family came off and commenced to take the anchors. Mrs. Burgess & Burgess came while they were heaving. What took the anchors & went to sea about 3 o'clock with a good breeze of the land. At sunset wind light the harbor about 20 miles off brought one Portuguese of from the Shore & Dorothea from the Brig Eunice Adams. So ends this day.
