

Remarks On Board Bark *Betha* of New Bedford

Wednesday Nov 19<sup>th</sup>

This day opens with lying at anchor and Steady breeze at daylight called all hands to set up the Staysail and employed in this light job about 12 o'clock our machine came off with the boat brought 4 some pumpkins and 6 men & one Boatsteeer that had shipped took up the boat. So ends this day

Thursday Nov 20<sup>th</sup>

This day opens with lying at anchor and Steady breeze at daylight called all hands and had breakfast and sent the boat to fetch one basket of bread 164 gallons & crew on shore in charge of this machine he came up about 1 o'clock brought 3 hys & goats & 2 sacks of oranges pumpkins and went back with the same crew. So ends this day

Friday Nov 21<sup>st</sup>

This day opens with lying at anchor went at wake at day breaking all water provisions with 2 bbls of oranges some hys then went and took up the 2 anchors and got underweigh with the vessel & sent the Boat in after the Capt<sup>s</sup> family with the same crew except one man that deserted the last time that the Boat went in he was a Portuguese & came on board about 2 months ago in *Sagat* Capt<sup>s</sup> family came up at 1 o'clock & the *Boat* shipped the men that came on board both took home on shore and Mr. Burgess came up about half past 5 o'clock took up the Boat & kept off at S W with all sail set. So ends this day

Saturday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day opens with light S. E. Trades Steering S. W. with all dancing watch employed in ships duty & an shackled the cables and put them below. So ends this day

Sunday Nov 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day opens with light S. E. Trades Steering S. W. about 12 o'clock saw black fish lowered all 3 boats each boat brought a piece to the ship & then went after those the Leeward & Waste Boat one more piece took up the Boats about 2 o'clock lost one from along side sawed 7. So ends this day

Monday Nov 24<sup>th</sup>

This day opens with light falling wind & rain squalls untill about 12 o'clock at 1 o'clock that breeze had a light breeze from N. E. watch employed in sailing out the black fish finished about 11 o'clock at the latter part wind the same Steering South with all sail set that wind drew. So ends this day

Tuesday Nov 25<sup>th</sup>

This day opens with light breeze from N. E. Steering South about 3 o'clock the came up squally & rainy took in light sails at 7 o'clock had good weather and made sail back to light breeze from N. E. watch employed in ships duty saw one Steamer So ends this day
