

Remarks On Board Bark Bertha of New Bedford

Wednesday Decr 13th

This day opens with a light breeze from the E. Steering by it heading S. E. with all sail out. Watch employed in washing clothes nothing in sight of land.

Lat. 16-32 South Long. 28-00 W. So ends this day

Thursday Decr 14th

This day opens with a light breeze from the E. Steering by it with all sail out heading about S. E. nothing in sight of land.

Lat. 17-35 South Long. 28-58 West So ends this day

Friday Decr 15th

This day opens with a light breeze from the E. Steering by it on the port tack heading from S. to S. E. watch employed in ships duty 2 sails in sight one of them a Whaling Bark. It appears she was on the S. Tack.

Lat. 18-54 South Long. — So ends this day

Saturday Decr 16th

This day opens with a good breeze from the E. Steering by it at daylight saw the Island of Trinidad about 7 o'clock saw Martin pass and the Rocks nearly ahead as bearing S. by W. was up to them at 2 o'clock. The lowered the Waste boat about half past 2 o'clock and Capt. went in a fishing and came back at 5 o'clock made all sail and kept by the wind heading S. E. by S. at sunset the Rocks about 10 miles off bearing N. by E. So ends this day.

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Wednesday Decr 17th

This day opens with a good breeze from the N. to E. Steering S. E. with all sail out. Watch employed in painting ship inside. Saw 4 sails going to the North.

Lat. 21-37 S. Long. 27-10 W. So ends this day

Thursday Decr 18th

This day opens with a light breeze from E. to E. Steering by it heading S. E. by S. watch employed in ships duty nothing in sight of land in sight.

Lat. 22-00 South Long. 26-48 West So ends this day

Friday Decr 19th

This day opens with a light breeze from the N. to E. Steering S. E. with all sail out. Watch employed in ships duty no sail in sight and prospers.

Lat. 23-28 South Long. 25-12 W. So ends this day

Saturday Decr 20th

This day opens with a light breeze from the N. to E. Steering S. E. until 5 o'clock S. by E. then kept S. E. wind North watch employed in washing clothes nothing in sight of land in sight.

Lat. 24-05 South Long. 24-12 W. So ends this day

Sunday Decr 21st

This day opens with a light breeze from the N. W. Steering S. E. with all drawing sail out nothing of land in sight latter part course South Wind West.

Lat. 25-12 South Long. 23-01
