by it on the east tack at sunrise made sail
and kept it till 10. Saw the land about one o'clock & the
watch employed in washing clothes saw five backs.
Black fish, porpoises and other small fish about
11. Made sail and came to the wind heading N.W.
Lat. 11-53 S

So ends this day
Sunday March 14th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steering
by it on the east tack heading N.W. at sunrise made sail
Nothing in sight but porpoises and caught one

Lat. 11-36 S Long. 14-15 W So ends this day
Monday March 15th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. Steering by it
on the east tack heading N.W. with all sail except main
sail. Watch employed in repairing it finished at 10. Put
it below nothing of note in sight at 10. Took in light sail.
Lat. 10-28 S Long. 10-58 W So ends this day

Tuesday March 16th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. Steering
by it at sunrise made sail and kept it till 10. Watch employed
in breaking provisions and emptying casks and kegs repairing
them. Saw nothing of note in light sail and five porpoises and
came to the wind on the Western tack

Lat. 08-39 S Long. 10-30 W So ends this day

Rabinsan Master Cruising off the Coast of Africa
Wednesday March 17th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. Steering by it
heading N.W. at sunrise made sail Watch employed
in ship's duty Nothing but porpoises in sight at sunset
Took in light sail heading N.W. by W.
Lat. 08-38 S Long. 08-50 W So ends this day

Thursday March 18th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steering
by it on the east tack at sunrise made sail
Watch employed in ship's duty Nothing in sight but
porpoises caught one. Ship heading N.W. at sunset
Lat. 08-28 S Long. 08-28 W So ends this day

Friday March 19th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steering
by it on the east tack at 10. Took in main kept it by the
Watch employed in ship's duty Nothing but
porpoises in sight

Lat. 08-25 S Long. 08-25 W So ends this day
Saturday March 20th

This day opens with a good breeze from the South
Steering N.W. by S. Watch employed in washing clothes
Nothing of note in sight

Lat. 10-11 S Long. 08-50 W

So ends this day
