Monday May 7th

This day opens with a light breeze from the South steering by it on the Starboard heading W by S. at 2 o'clock Mr. went around Watch displayed in Ship's Dock. Nothing of note in sight at Sunset took in light sails & took off Duty.

Lat 12-55 S. Long 157-02 E. So ends this day

Tuesday May 8th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. steering by it on the Starboard heading W by S. at 1 o'clock Mr. went around Watch employed in washing clothes. Nothing in sight at sunset took in light sails and went on the Starboard heading S by E. took off Duty.

Lat 12-57 S. Long 157-22 E. So ends this day

Wednesday May 9th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. steering by it on the Starboard heading S by E. at Sunrise hauled sail at 12 o'clock went on the Starboard heading W at Sunset took in light sails & took off Duty.

Lat 12-58 S. Long 157-05 E. So ends this day

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Thursday May 10th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S. steering by it on the Starboard heading W at 2 o'clock went around with the Starboard heading S by E. hauled main top gallant sail & flying jib. Watch employed in Ship's Dock on Duty.

Lat 12-56 S. Long 157-02 E. So ends this day

Friday May 11th

This day opens with a good breeze from the South steering by it on the Starboard heading from S by E to S at 2 o'clock Mr. set flying jib and gaff top sail and went down main top gallant sail and went to repairing it at 12 o'clock went about heading W by S. Nothing in sight at Sunset took in light sails.

Lat 12-40 S. Long 157-05 E. So ends this day

Saturday May 12th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S. steering by it on the Starboard heading W by S. at Sunrise hauled sail. Watch finished the main top gallant sail and bent it there and down the spinnaker. Nothing in sight of land at Sunset went around on the Starboard heading W took in light sails & jib.

Lat 13-00 S. Long 157-51 E. So ends this day
