

Remarks for Board Bark Brothers of New Bedford
Friday July 16th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight the three boats went cruising Capt. got the ship underway and steered to the N. W. along the land in company with Bark Wanderer. Had a strong light breeze from the S. W. about sunset boats came along side and one whale going quick let go anchor in 11 fathoms of water & 30 fathoms of chain about 2 o'clock P. M. So ends this day

Saturday July 17th

This day opens lying at anchor with a strong breeze from the S. W. at daylight lowered down two boats. Several whale shaped on board and helped get the ship underway and steered down the coast until about one o'clock P. M. and off Long Bay in 10 fathoms of water & 30 fathoms of chain about dark boats came along side saw nothing

Sunday July 18th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent three boats & cruising saw one whale chased him down to the ship and got him up and came on board about five o'clock P. M. So ends this day

Monday July 19th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent the three boats & cruising saw one whale chased him about three hours and got him up came along side about dark Bark Wanderer saw two whales one of them was sick had a pin in him they struck and killed and towed along side about sunset

So ends this day

Robinson Master Humphreys of Long Bay
Tuesday July 20th

This day opens lying at anchor at daylight sent three boats off & cruising saw two whales could not get on them they was going quick and it was calm about all day about dark boats came along side So ends this day

Wednesday July 21st

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight two boats went & cruising soon after the Capt. and third mate lowered down saw several whales and chased them but it was calm and they was going quick Capt. came to the ship about one o'clock about 2 o'clock P. M. saw one whale Mrs. Briggs struck and then the other 2 boats struck killed and towed him to the vessel put the fluke chain on about six o'clock P. M. the fourth boat helped tow the whale

15 lbs Mrs. Briggs.

So ends this day

Thursday July 22nd

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight sent three boats & cruising Capt. sent in the whale and saw some from the vessel and lowered for them but they was going quick and had it calm most of the time came on board about 2 o'clock P. M. the other three boats came along side about dark So ends this day
