

Remarks On Board Bark Beulah of New Bedford
Friday July 23rd

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight Two
boats went @ cruising Started the work about a clock
to in and boiled out the oil finished about 8 o'clock & the boats
Saw one Whale chased him about three hours had a light
breeze all day

So ends this day
Saturday July 24th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight Three
boats went @ cruising had a light breeze about half of the
day Saw nothing came along side about dark So ends

Sunday July 25th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight Two boats
went off the rest of the crew got the ship underweigh
and started in W. had a light breeze from the S.W. until
about four o'clock at five anchored in 22 fathoms and 18
fathoms of chain boats came along side about dark did not
See any Whales

So ends this day

Monday July 26th

This day opens with lying at anchor Two boats went @
cruising the rest of the crew took the anchor at daylight
and started in W. had it calm until 11 o'clock then had
a light breeze which lasted until about 5 o'clock then
anchored in 9 fathoms and 20 fathoms of chain and boats
came along side about the same time Saw no Whales

So ends this day

Tuesday July 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight 2 boats
went @ cruising remainder of the crew got the ship underweigh
had a light breeze from West W. until 5 o'clock & then about
that time boats came along side Saw 2 Whales going quick
chased but without success at 7 o'clock anchored in 12 fathoms
of water and 20 fathoms of chain So ends this day

Wednesday July 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 2 o'clock called all
hands and got underweigh at daylight Three boats went
off Saw 2 Whales chased at one but not near enough then
shot a bomb lance but did not hit him then they started
up and gave them up came along side about 5 o'clock
at 7. let go anchor in 10 fathoms of water had a light
breeze most of the day So ends this day

Thursday July 29th

This day opens with lying at anchor at 5 o'clock took up
the anchor and made sail and started to the North Three
boats went @ cruising Saw one Whale about 2 o'clock & the
let go anchor about half of 4 mile from Bark Savannah
had taken 100 blb. and had 2 Whales along side
boats came along side about sunset anchored in 10 fathoms
Water off Monday Bay So ends this day
