

Remarks On Board Bark Bertha of New Bedford
Thursday August 5th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight. Made
a third mate went to cruising Saw several Whales but no
abundance had the wind light boats came along side at 11 o'clock

Friday August 6th
This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight 2 boats
went to cruising third mate helped get the vessel underweigh
about 9 o'clock about dark let go anchor along side the
Bark Licensa Sticksen. Master had no bbls of oil. This
Season boats came along side about dark Saw several
Whales but most of them going South at 7 o'clock
Started the vessel So ends this day

Saturday August 7th
This day opens with lying at anchor and hoisting and oil
finished about 1 o'clock. Then Second & Third mate
cruising Saw several Whales but could not get an
haul @ good breeze So ends this day

Sunday August 8th
This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight called
all hands and went to work getting the ship underweigh
about 9 o'clock Saw 10 Whales and lowered 2 & started boats
soon after saw 200 the other two boats saw more Whales
at 11 o'clock Cooper let go anchor about 1 o'clock & the
Capt. came on board and got underweigh anchored again
at 9 o'clock about that time boats came along side plenty of
Whales in sight started once but too far to reach them
haul @ good breeze So ends this day

Robinson Master Bound To Providence
Monday August 9th

This day opens with lying at anchor at daylight three boats
went to cruising Saw several Whales but could not get
near them boats came along side about 11 o'clock So ends

Tuesday August 10th
This day opens with lying at anchor three boats went to
cruising Saw 5 Whales at 1 o'clock 11 o'clock all hands came
on board and took up the anchor and made all sail
bound to Providence With a good breeze from the South
steering N. W. & W. So ends this day

Wednesday August 11th
This day opens with a light breeze from the South
steering N. W. & W. with all sail and water employed
in taking down oil and cleaning down and cleaning
up the deck Saw the land about 10 o'clock and the
Saw 1000 Whales
Saw 2000 Whales 5-55 So ends this day

Thursday August 12th
This day opens with a good breeze from S. W. steering
N. W. by W. with all sail and water employed in washing
ship inside Saw 2000 Whales and 1000 fish
So ends this day
