

Remarks for Board Barge Beathan of New Bedford

Thursday Sept. 24th

This day opens with a light breeze from the S.W. Steaming by
at 11 AM. Put back at 12 o'clock & in wind arrived at
daylight saw 2 Whalers. Sec. Haniel & Wanderer garrick
with them saw another ship called at the Staff House
gave up going about 2 o'clock P.M. and made all sail
and kept S.E. Lat. 45:52 Long. 10:50. So ends this day

Friday Sept. 25th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steaming
S.E. The Wanderer and Sec. Haniel in sight and saw
large hump back and porpoises. Watch employed in Ship's Duty
about 2 o'clock took up 30 fathoms of cable and took the
anchor of the S. H. H. and it ready to let go

Lat. 45:50 South Long. 10:50 So ends this day

Saturday Sept. 26th

This day opens with a good breeze from the S.W. Steaming
S.E. with all sail set saw the land at 2 o'clock P.M.
then kept on & crossed Long River about 6 o'clock
Saw 4 vessels bound in to Ketchikan. Saw hump backs
going to the S. at 2 o'clock P.M. anchored in 2 fathoms
of water about 3 miles from Ketchikan harbor. Watch
employed in Ship's Duty and took the port anchor
of the boat and hauled up 30 fathoms of chain and
went in all ready to let go. Used made and in
Beathouse took the watches

Sunday Sept. 27th

This day opens with lying at anchor called all hands
at 5 o'clock and took the anchor as soon as the wind came
to shore and went in the Bay and anchored about 2 o'clock
P.M. pulled the sails and most of the crew went on shore
all came in at sunset beside the Beathouse still at anchor

Monday Sept. 28th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in working ship and breaking out shades. The Cooper
setting them up

So ends this day

Tuesday Sept. 29th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in clearing iron work & helping set up Charles D. Hanks

Wednesday Sept. 30th

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in clearing iron work and other light jobs. So ends this day

Thursday Sept. 31st

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in Ship's Duty

So ends this day

Friday Sept. 1st

This day opens with lying at anchor all hands employed
in painting ship and side and turning down the fore & aft stays

So ends this day
